CHAIR, Dale Diedrich called the November 10, 2022 monthly township meeting to order @ 7:00 pm with the Pledge of Allegiance. Supervisors Brent Ost and Bob Hansen, Treasurer Barb Guenther, Don Kalpin of FD, Road Maintenance Engineer Richard Vogt, Jeff Stabnow Engineer, and 4 residents living on Little Ida BH. Rd. and Clerk present.

CLERK read the minutes of the October 13, 2022 meeting. Motion was made and second with Dale, Brent and Bob voting aye to accept the prepared and read minutes, no other discussion motion carried.

TREASURER gave the prepared monthly financial report. There was a balance of \$665,010.73 in the General, Road/Bridge and Fire Funds; First Responder Fund \$8,823.18, Park Fund \$25,515.65, Hall Maintenance Fund \$50,585.84 and COVID Fund \$49,447.89. Balance in Checking account was \$2,072.89 and there was income for township of \$18,218.81; Treasurer transferred \$4,000.00 from savings into checking. Motion was made and second to accept this report as prepared and read with Dale, Brent and Bob voting aye, no other discussion motion carried. Treasurer continued to prepare checks for Board.

Dale discussed the progress and completion that was made on the tarring project on Little Ida Bh. Rd the last couple weeks. The driveway approaches off of road of some residents and swing away mail box supports and the shoulders on road were items that may need to be completed in spring. Residents, Board and Jeff all agreed that Mark Lee's Excavating did an excellent job on this project. The financing and payment of the project was briefly discussed but all information will be available at the December meeting and then a letter will be sent to all residents informing them of the cost of project and payment choices. At this time all discussed reasons why speed limit sign will not be installed on this road.

The new fire pickup will be ordered from Diamond GMC when it is available from company.

RBS and Board discussed culverts that were installed and that some of township roads are in need of blading as soon as weather allows.

Motion was made and second to donate to Ebenezer church the play-ground set from the ball park with Dale, Brent and Bob voting aye. Sportsmans Club will remove it when newly purchased play-set is installed, motion carried.

Board reviewed building permits and mail, Treasurer had all checks prepared for Board to review, approve and sign #1583 to #1606, voiding out #'s 1591 & 1598. General Fund totaled \$6,076.19, Road/Bridge Fund totaled \$2,996.00, Fire Fund \$757.09, First Responder Fund totaled \$300.60 and Park Fund totaled \$38,975.71 all funds totaled \$49,105.59. Motion was made and second to accept and pay all receipts with Dale, Brent and Bob voting aye, no other discussion motion carried.

At this time there was no other township business needing to be addressed motion was made and second to adjourn with Dale, Brent and Bob voting aye, motion carried. 8:00 pm
