

The Covenant from the Foundation of the World

The Covenant from the Foundation of the World is a fundamental teaching in the Bible. Understanding this Covenant is of utmost importance. It has been hidden for millennia and now the time has come for it to be brought to light.

The Covenant from the Foundation of the World is the agreement between the Father, the Son, and Holy Spirit as to the purpose of the physical world in which we all live. This agreement was made "before" the Foundation of the World. The physical world is the execution of this agreement. This Covenant has been revealed throughout the history of mankind in the 7 Everlasting Covenants even though it has been hidden from the beginning.

The Covenant from the Foundation of the World is as follows:



The Covenant from the Foundation of the World

The Bible is a Book of Covenants revealed throughout the history of mankind. All of the Everlasting Covenants between God and man reveal the Covenant from the Foundation of the World. The Covenant from the Foundation of the World is embedded in the 7 words of the first sentence in Genesis. It is also contained in the 12 words of the second sentence of Genesis as well.

The Covenant from the Foundation of the World is as follows:

God Created the Earth as a House for the Son of God to take a Bride and He would be Responsible for His Bride even if it cost Him His very Life because He would be Nailed to Connect Heaven and Earth.

This teaching will focus on proving this concept in the Hebrew. We will be taking each of these bolded phrases and showing them in the original Hebrew.

- 1. God Created the Earth as a House
- 2. For the Son of God
- 3. To Take a Bride and
- 4. He would be Responsible for his Bride even if it Cost Him His Very Life Because He would Be Nailed to Connect Heaven and Earth.

Please take a moment to look at the center section of this teaching. The pattern you see will be explained in this teaching.

God Created the Earth as a House



The Enlarged Bet

The first word in the Bible has a letter that is always drawn larger than the other letters. It is the letter "Bet" and is done this way in every Torah scroll because there is a teaching associated with this letter.



The teaching of the Enlarged Bet is the teaching of the House. It is the first teaching in the Bible.

The letter Bet means "House". It was originally drawn as a house and is used often in scripture to mean house. Bethel means "House of God". Bethlehem means "House of Bread".

I believe that the Enlarged Bet was placed in the first sentence of the Bible to give definition to that sentence. The Bible is the Story of the Heavens and the Earth, but we will see in the first chapter of Genesis that the "making" of the Earth is the primary focus of Genesis Chapter 1.

The second sentence of the Bible starts with the words "And the Earth". It is telling the story of the Earth. We learn from John 1:3 that the "Word" does the making of the Earth. He is building His House.

All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.

Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world:

Matthew 25:34

If I was forced to decide on a favorite scripture in the Bible, Matthew 25:34 is it. The phrase "inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world" explains so much in regards to the eternal plan of God. Not only is the Son of God building a house for His Bride, He is building an Eternal Kingdom for His people. He is the Eternal King of the Universe and we will Rule with Him Forever.

To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne.

Revelation 3:21

And he that overcometh, and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations: And he shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father. Revelation 2:26-27

I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, the first and the last. Blessed are they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.

I am Alpha and Omega, the Beginning and the End, the First and the Last.

Revelation 22:13

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

John 1:1

Understanding the Eternal Nature of the Son of God is of utmost importance in our study of scripture. We are told in Revelation 22:13 that He is the Alpha and Omega, the Beginning and the End, the First and the Last. Yeshua (Jesus) did not begin His existence at His Incarnation, He always was and always will be. He is Eternal.

The Greek Letters **Alpha and Omega** directly correspond to the Hebrew Letters **Aleph and Tav**. These are the first and last letters in each language respectively. The word "Aleph Tav" is the **fourth word** in the first sentence in Genesis. It is the direct object pointer in Hebrew but more inportantly, it represents the Eternal Messiah as the Son of God, the "**Word**" from the Beginning.



I am fascinated by the Wisdom of God in His Word. God embedded His plan in the first sentences of the Bible with special characters and numbers.

Remember the former things of old: for I am God, and there is none else; I am God, and there is none like me,

Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure:

Isaiah 46:9-10

The fact that the Bible starts with 7 words and 7 means Covenant is explained in the Mystery of 7 teaching. The second sentence has 12 words. 12 is the number of the People of God and the Bride.

THE BIBLE IS THE STORY OF GOD AND HIS COVENANT WITH MANKIND. THE STORY OF THE 7 AND THE 12.

Please count the words for yourself in the above hebrew text.



We see the number 12 all thoughout scripture associated with the people of God. The 12 Tribes of Israel, the 12 Apostles, etc.

In the Mystery of 12 teaching, I explain that the 12 words in the second sentence of Genesis give the state of the earth at the start of the "making". The "making" is the story of the Messiah forming the earth into a "House" for His Bride. He is the Bridegroom and we are the Bride.

In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.

John 14:2-3

And Jesus said unto them, Can the children of the bridechamber mourn, as long as the bridegroom is with them? but the days will come, when the bridegroom shall be taken from them, and then shall they fast.

Matthew 9:15

Then shall the kingdom of heaven be likened unto ten virgins, which took their lamps, and went forth to meet the bridegroom.

Matthew 25:1

While the bridegroom tarried, they all slumbered and slept.

And at midnight there was a cry made, Behold, the bridegroom cometh; go ye out to meet him.

Matthew 25:5-6



And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea.

And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God.

Revelation 21:1-3

These 3 scriptures reveal the Plan of God, that which was from the Beginning. The House, the Bride, God Dwelling with His People, the Restoration of All Things.

And there came unto me one of the seven angels which had the seven vials full of the seven last plagues, and talked with me, saying, Come hither, I will shew thee the bride, the Lamb's wife.

And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God, having the Glory of God: and her light was like unto a stone most precious, even like a jasper stone, clear as crystal; And had a wall great and high, and had twelve gates, and at the gates twelve angels, and names written thereon, which are the names of the twelve tribes of the children of Israel:

Revelation 21:9-13



On the east three gates; on the north three gates; on the south three gates; and on the west three gates. And the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and in them the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.


Revelation 21:14

Earlier in this teaching, we discussed the correlation between the **Alpha and Omega** in the Book of Revelation and the **Aleph and Tav** in Hebrew. The Sages of Israel have questioned the meaning of the Aleph Tav in Scripture for millennia. The Aleph Tav appears over and over in the Hebrew Scriptures. Yeshua (Jesus) solved this riddle for us in the book of Revelation when He said that He was the Alpha and Omega, the Aleph and Tav.

The letter Vav \ \ \ is the Hebrew letter for the word "and" and has the pictorgraphic meaning of a Nail. It is a Nail that connects physical things and the word "and" that connects ideas in language. The sixth word of Genesis 1:1 is V'et. It is a picture of the Aleph Tav being Nailed to Connect the Heavens and the Earth.

There can be no question that Yeshua (Jesus) wants us to understand His Eternal Nature. He is the Beginning and the End, the First and the Last, the Aleph and the Tav.

It is incredible to me that in the very first line of scripture, we have a picture of the Messiah nailed to connect the Heavens and the Earth. The Gospel Message from the Beginning.
