#### PASTOR'S PEN



As we explore the person of Moses, we notice how listening is what set him apart from the others. Listening *well* is not simply hearing the words being said, it's also feeling the emotions being felt. People usually don't want solutions as much as they just want to be understood. This is hard to remember as we are a solution focused society. Moses, and many people of faith were able to listen to the "still, small voice" that speaks to them.

What's one area of your life that you keep trying to "solve" instead of simply understanding? This doesn't have to necessarily be a relationship either. People try to "solve" their health problems with fad diets, or pills when often what is first needed is to develop an awareness of the emotions that enable the problems in the first place.

In my own life, I've often tried to "solve" my creativity by over-planning books and projects, when really I just needed to sit down and create and understand what I was feeling. It is funny how doing more can actually become the distraction.

Try being a better listener this month—of others, but also of yourself. Don't just focus on the information, focus on the feeling. Then sit with that feeling. Don't try to fix it or push it away. Just let it be there and then simply seek to understand why it's there.

New Heating Oil Season is here. As you saw in the September newsletter will spend nearly \$16,000.00 on heating oil this 2023-2024 season. In September we learned that our annual Maintenance contract bill will come in October and that is a one-time additional charge of about \$700.00



We have a new Mascot for our Heating Oil campaign, <u>SUPER MEER</u> from Vacation Bible School! As we learned in VBS, Meerkats "dig and tunnel" so we are asking that our members do their best to "dig down" and contribute monthly a little extra using the OIL envelopes you'll find at the Heating Oil Campaign poster board located in the Hospitality area to help us deal with the 16,000.00 + 700.00 for maintenance to keep us warm.

Here is their memory cross:


