

Fall Arrives This Month!

Summer has been here and we did see a summer slump in our giving. Not quite as much as last year, but we still had to liquidate \$4,000 over the months of June, July and August whereas last year it was \$5,000. We don't want to be in the situation of liquidating. We are confident that with your support we can turn that around as we roll into Fall.

New Heating Oil Season is here! Speaking of Fall, as fast as time flies can Winter be far behind? And with it another heating season. We did see a monthly reduction in our budgeted amount since we ended 2022-2023 with a balance and the price of oil has stabilized some. BUT we will still spend nearly \$16,000.00 on heating oil this 2023-2024 season.



We are going to have a new Mascot for our Heating Oil campaign, SUPER MEER from Vacation Bible School! As we learned in VBS, Meerkats "dig and tunnel" so we'll ask that our members do their best to "dig down" and contribute monthly a little extra using the OIL envelopes you'll find at the Heating Oil Campaign poster board located in the Hospitality area to help us deal with the \$16,000.00 a season oil bill.

Why not simplify and make giving easy and automatic? Here are two ways you can do that:

- 1. Your Bank You can set up a monthly cashier's check to be drawn on one of your accounts and mailed to the church. This is a recurring process so you don't have to worry about it! For example Wells Fargo will help you set this up at no cost to you! Contact your bank and they can help you set it up.
- 2. Tithely Consider using the safe, secure, easy virtual method with the QR code with your smart phone. There are also buttons on our website and Facebook pages. Tithely can also set up a recurring, automatic monthly donation using one of your credit cards. There is a nominal fee with this.


