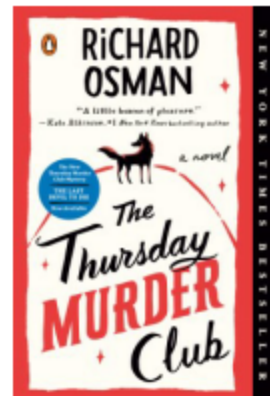
Just a reminder that if the Lakeview School District is closed due to inclement weather, the library is closed also. All programs will be cancelled and due dates for that day will be extended.

Free to use on our computers. Stop in and check out the new folder with tips and tricks reserching family records and military history.

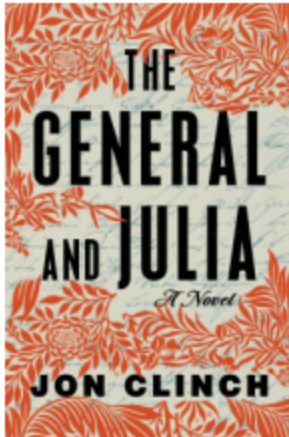
Libby

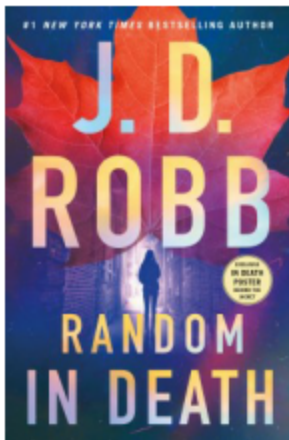

by Jon Clinch

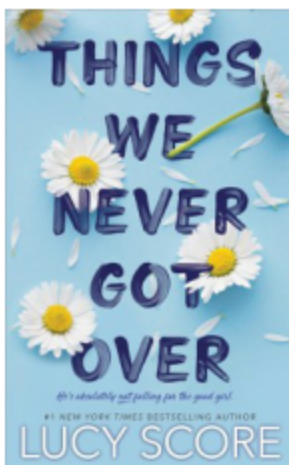

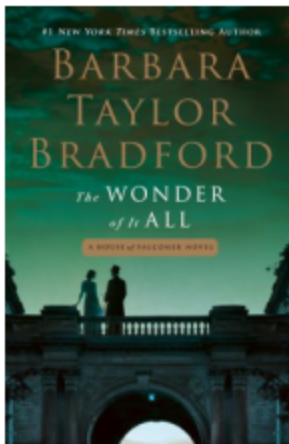
