

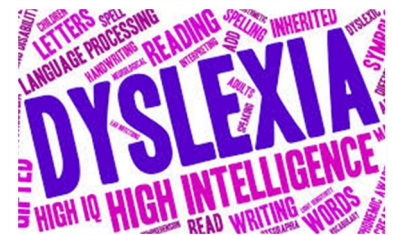
Orton-Gillingham Training
