Greetings from Immanuel Baptist Church! We hope that you had a blessed and joyful Christmas season with your family and friends! We most certainly remained busy during the month of December, with multiple events to celebrate the birth of our Savior.

In the month of December, we paused our series on 1 John and started a short advent series titled "Reason for the Season" which went through the first of the month until Christmas day. This series focused on why Jesus came to this world (to seek and save the lost), and how we as Christians can refocus our hearts during this busy season, back to Christ, the focal point of the Christmas season.

Along with this sermon series, Immanuel also hosted multiple events to celebrate the Christmas season. On the Sunday before Christmas, we hosted a Candlelight Service, then on Christmas morning, we hosted our regular Sunday service. Both events were well attended and brought much joy! During this month, we had plans to have our annual Children's Program, however, due to avid sickness throughout our church, we had to postpone until January (when the program was held, the kids and volunteers did a fantastic job!).

As we transition into 2023, our church has its focus on three specific areas in the ministry. (1) Kingdom Building (community outreach), (2) Missions, and (3) Discipleship.

First, for Kingdom Building, our primary focus will be serving the surrounding communities, whether that be picking up trash along the highways, serving the elderly in nursing homes, or shut-ins, or wherever else we can do to show the love of Christ to our community.

Secondly, for Missions, we are burdened with the thought that many in this world don't even know the name of Christ, let alone know about the salvation He provides. Romans 10 says, "How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching? [15] And how are they to preach unless they are sent? As it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!". With this passage in mind, we as a church want to better support our brothers and sisters in Christ who are currently on the mission field, spreading the Gospel to those who haven't yet heard it. We will be having various events in the upcoming year such as inviting missionaries to come to our church and speak about the work they are doing overseas. We hope that this will spark excitement and awareness for missions.

Lastly, for Discipleship, we want to see continued spiritual growth within our congregation, so to aid this, we will be implementing congregant-led small groups in various communities around the

Bethany, Eagleville, and Gilman City areas. These small groups will meet at various homes around these areas. We hope they will provide more fellowship opportunities across a wide array of age groups and backgrounds, furthering discipleship growth within our church.

We have recently started reciting parts of the "New City Catechism" (Gospel Coalition). These catechisms are recited weekly in question-and-answer format (Pastor reads the question, and the congregation reads the answer in unison), along with aiding scripture. If you are unfamiliar with catechisms, these question-and-answer-based theological statements are to be read aloud and repeated often. An example of a catechism is, "what is our only hope in life and death", to which the congregant would respond, "That we are not our own but belong, body and soul, both in life and death, to God and our Savior Jesus Christ". These catechisms break down big chunks of theology into bite-sized, memorable pieces, which we hope to find useful in equipping the saints for ministry.

We continually pray for you all and hope that this upcoming year will bring much joy, peace, and happiness to all of your churches! May God bless each of your ministries, and lead and guide each and every one of you!
