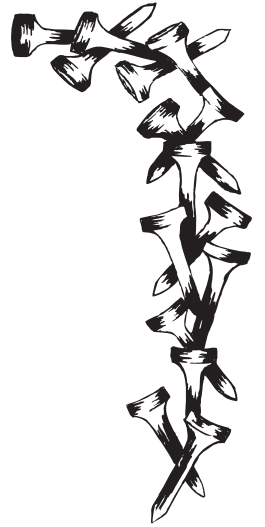
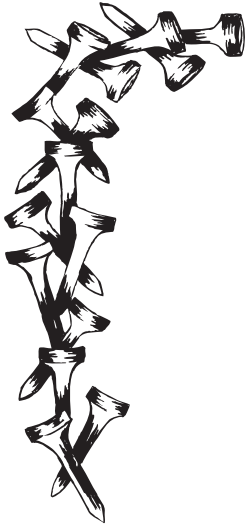

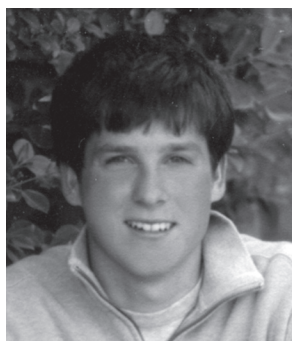


2011 Boys All State Super Team



11 Otto Black Pinckney Bruce Rabbitt

Otto had a great season. As a junior he made All Conference. He led the Pirates to a 1st place finish in the KLAA Lakes West Division. He also led the team to a 1st place overall in a very strong conference meet shooting four under par 68. Posting a score of 73 allowed Otto another 1st place finish which helped his team win the district championship. His 4th place score of 72 took the team to a 3rd place finish at the regional helping them reach the MHSAA State Finals. Starting out the 1st day at the finals he fired a 71 to lead the field and followed up on the 2nd day with a 75 for a 146 total and a 4th place finish. As the captain he rallied the team the evening of day one and the Pirates went from 6th place to a 3rd place finish on the final day of the state finals under his leadership. Otto had the type of attitude throughout the season that was conducive to being a great competitive golfer. He was willing to work as hard as was necessary to give himself a competitive edge over his opponent. He also has a great demeanor on the course that allows him to compete at the highest level while being cordial to his opponents. Otto was respected by players, coaches and parents and referred to as a “great kid” by all who encounter him. He was recognized by his coach as a fine team captain who encouraged all his teammates to play their best in a positive manner. Always thinking of his team, he took time on the range and practice green to assist any team mate who asked him for help.



12 Patrick Colburn Traverse City Central Dave McMellan

Patrick finished as medalist in nine invitationals and led his team to the BNC Conference Championship. He was medalist in every conference event and his conference average was 69.17. He continued that playing style by finishing in the top ten every time he teed the ball up over the entire season and finished the year with an average of 72.24 and an impressive 29 putts per round through 17 rounds of golf. Patrick’s playing ability led the team to the Division 1 State Finals. Patrick’s selection to the 2011 Boy’s All-state super team represents the culmination of an outstanding high school golf career. A four-year letter winner at Traverse City Central High School, he has earned All-State honors as a freshman, sophomore and junior, while being named to the Super Team as a senior. This impressive four year stretch of high school golf success began his freshman year, when as a ninth grader, he placed 3rd in the state finals and led his team to the Division IV state championship. He finished tied for seventh in the Division 1 state finals as a senior.

Nick completed his high school career with a State Finals finish tied for 4th place. He was the true definition of a “range rat.” He worked tirelessly on his game, and his work ethic was a great example for the younger players to follow. Through his quiet leadership, he made it known to all his teammates that in order to have success, you have to put in the time. Nick is currently attending Loyola University – Chicago and it is this dedication that will bring him success as he begins his college golf career.

At Regionals he fired a 69 and topped off his golf season at the MHSAA States carding 74, 67 for a two day total of 141. He was also medalist at the MIAC Conference Championship with a 71 and was named to the All Conference Team. Henry was medalist or tied for medalist at: the Kalamazoo Christian Invitational where he carded a 74, Manchester Invitational with another 74 and Grosse Ile Invitational firing a 72. He had a 36.1 scoring average for 9 holes and lead the team to a second place finish in the Division 4 State Finals. Henry excelled in the classroom as well with a 3.89 GPA.

Aaron is an exceptional teammate and team leader. As co-captain on this year's team, his work ethic and dedication to his game and the team helped guide the team to a second place finish at both Districts and Regionals. Aaron is also a confident and humble young man, always willing to help the other boys on the team with their own game.

As a junior, Max finished #1 on the team with a season average of 37.1. He was medalist in 4 invitationals. He was selected to OAA White Division all Division 1st Team, Observer Newspaper 1st team, 1st team All Oakland County, was most valuable player on the team and was one of the team captains. Max is currently collecting donations from the Detroit media community for the Cancer Awareness Day silent auction at Twin Beach Country Club. Max's mom battled stage III breast cancer in the summer of 2007. So raising money for cancer research is something that's very important to Max. It's also why he wore pink during his tournaments. In the off season, Max organizes practices and helps in the development of incoming freshman for next year's team. Max is a very hard worker and a disciplined player of the game. He can often be seen on the practice green after a match or tournament working on his putting and chipping. When our practices were done during the season, Max often returned to the range or course after supper to continue to work on his game. Max finished the season winning the MHSAA Individual State title for Division 1 with a two day total of 144 (73-71).

From Birmingham, Michigan, there is an individual who showed great character and had a stellar year during the spring of 2011. In terms of character, a few of his teammates were asked to give one or two words that best describe him: consistent, hard-working, confident, talented and a true gentleman towards teammates and his peers both on and off the course. In his spare time, he actively raised money for Karmanos Cancer Research which was our Team Community project for the Spring 2011 season. On the course, his accomplishments were outstanding. He shot an even par 70 at the Azure Dynamics invite at Oakland Hills Country Club – North course. At the Holiday Inn Express Invite, held at Orchard Lake Country Club, he shot a 1 over 73, to place second individually. His best round of the year came when he played in the Pinckney Invite, held at Rush Lake, where he carded a school record, 7 under par – 66, to win Medalist Honors. At District, he shot a 4 under par – 68, followed by a 69 at the Regional held at Lyon Oaks. At the MHSAA State Finals Division I, he finished 3rd, only to miss being in the playoffs by 1 shot. Once again, he fired a 2 under par – 70, on the second day of States. In other words, 4 rounds – under par, 2 rounds even par and had 9 top 10 finishes. His scoring average was 71.5, an outstanding record for any golfer, especially, for one in just his sophomore year. Francesco Ruffino, “Franny”, from Birmingham Seaholm High school, is the first sophomore to win the Prestigious Mr. Golf Award. He also has won Seaholm's “Pete Green” MVP award the last 2 years.





11 Bryan Vandenberg Gull Lake

Bryan is a junior and has been a three-year starter and letter winner. He finished first overall in the Wolverine Conference last year and was second this year. He finished first or tied for first in three jamborees this year and was in the top ten in all but one league jamboree. It was in tournament play that Bryan really excelled. He was first in the Kalamazoo Christian and Greater Kalamazoo tournaments. He finished in the top five in all tournaments entered. In state competition Bryan was the medalist in both the district and regional tournaments. At Forest Akers East, in the State Finals, he finished in a tie for second overall which included the low round of the finals, a 66. Bryan has been a team captain the past two seasons and has exhibited great sportsmanship and leadership. He is one of the finest golfers in the state. Coach Pearson states, "Bryan leads by example and is always willing to help and work with his teammates."



11 Andrew Yeager Forest Hills Central

Coach TenEyck states, "Andrew is one of the finest players and young men that I have had the privilege to coach." Not only is he a leader on the course, but also in the classroom, where he currently has a 4.05 GPA. On the course this spring, Andrew followed up his All State sophomore season with an outstanding junior season. He was named to the OK Black All-Conference team for the third time. Andrew's season started with a bang by winning the 2-day Traverse City Tee Off by shooting even par for both days and winning medalist honors. He also earned medalist honors at the District and Regional tournaments. In all, Andrew finished in the top 10 fourteen times this season. Andrew's outstanding play at the State Finals, where he finished 9th overall, helped Forest Hills Central to the Division 1 State Championship. His tournament average was an outstanding 73.56. Andrew has firmly staked his place as one of the best players in the history of the FHC golf program.

12 Chloe Lawrie Powers Catholic Jim Snow

Chloe, a senior, has been a 4-year starter on the Powers Charger golf team. She has had a phenomenal high school golf career at Powers which included a Division III State Championship as a freshman, and being named All State her sophomore and junior years. She followed up a great junior season with a fantastic senior season. She completely dominated her conference, by winning both conference tournaments and all matches. She had a sensational 37.7 conference average blowing away her competition. She also played well in outside competition, by either winning or being runner up in seven of 9 and 18-hole tournaments. She was 3rd in two others. She capped off her very fine high school career by winning the Division IV individual state title in a playoff. Her effort paid off and she was named to the MIGCA Super Team for this year. Chloe led the Charger golf team to an undefeated conference championship and to a runner-up finish in the Division IV State Championships. Wow, what a career! Chloe is a fine golfer but more than that she is a student with a 4.19 GPA, a great leader and a great young lady.



12 Hannah Lewis Plainwell Bart Lewis

Hannah, a four year letter winner, picked up golf as an incoming freshman. This year she has led her team to their second team conference title as well as moving on to own the regional team title for the first time in Lady Trojan golf history. For the second year in a row Hannah has claimed both the individual Wolverine Conference Tournament title and the Regional Tournament crown shooting a one under par 74 at Binder Park to help take her team to the Division III State Finals for the first time in school history. Hannah set the school record with low rounds of 33 for 9 holes and 68 for 18. Her two scores of 68 this year tied course records at Stonehedge North and Winding Creek. Out of 15 events Hannah had 11 medalist finishes, 3 runner up finishes including the Division 3 State Finals, and 1 top five finish. Hannah has made First Team All Wolverine Conference as well as All County Golf team for four years. This is her third year as captain of the Lady Trojan squad. Hannah holds a 4.02 GPA and is involved in many activities. For the second season in a row she has been named Wolverine Conference Outstanding Golfer finishing as the overall conference medalist with a 9-hole stroke average of 37.4 last year and 37.9 this season. She culminated a stellar high school four season run with an individual runner up finish at the Division 3 State Finals at Forest Akers West shooting 81-84. She has a 75.3 Tournament Average. Hannah's hard work has earned her three consecutive team MVP awards. She was honored to be elected as First Team All State after a standout junior season last year. She will play collegiate golf with the Bowling Green State University Falcons.





11 Kelsey Murphy Plymouth Chris Moore

Kelsey, a junior, had a sensational golf season. She finished in the top three in all six of our tournaments this year. She finished first at the conference tournament for a 3rd straight year, shooting an impressive one over par 73 at Pheasant Run. She also won the Highest Honor Golf Invite at Huron Meadows, shooting a career best one under par 71. She earned first or second place in all of our dual matches this season. She had a nine-hole average of 38.0 and her eighteen-hole average was 76.50. Kelsey was 3rd at the Regional played at University of Michigan Golf Course and she capped her great season by finishing 3rd at the windy Division One State Finals at The Meadows. She was named All Area and All Conference team for a third straight year and was chosen for the First Team KLAA. She has been a true leader on this team since her freshman year. She also has a great understanding of the rules of golf, and her integrity is second to none. She puts in a tremendous amount of extra time at the course preparing for each match and sets up her practices to focus on her weaknesses. She sets goals for herself and she understands what it takes to accomplish those goals throughout the season.



10 Elle Nichols Okemos Danial Stolz

Elle Nichols is a sophomore captain for the League Champion Okemos Chieftains. Elle was the top golfer in the conference with the lowest average and won the season opening 18-hole event and the final 18-hole event. Elle also won the Division 2 Regional at Milham GC and then won the State Division 2 Tournament played at Katke-Cousins. Elle placed 5th at last year's State tournament her freshman year and was also First team all league. Elle is a wonderful person, great leader, terrific athlete and excellent student with a 3.78 GPA. Her 9-Hole match average is 38.7 and her tournament average is 79.7. She had nine top 10 finishes in tournament play and was named First Team CAAC Blue.





11 Hannah Pietila Brighton Paul Parsell

Hannah is a 3-year varsity letter winner and had an outstanding junior season, as a team captain. She is known as the "Bulldog" by her coach and her teammates, she has been given this nickname because she is a bit stubborn on the golf course, much like a bulldog is. As a team we believe Brighton Bulldogs are dedicated, determined and hard working much like Hannah. She finished as the medalist at 6 invites; the Traverse City's Lober Invite, Brighton's invite, Ann Arbor Pioneer's invite, East Lansing invite and also Bedford's invite this season. Hannah was also undefeated in conference play averaging 36 on 9 holes. Hannah help lead her team this season to a division and conference championship. She was the medalist at the conference championship at Lakeland Country Club. She finished as a runner up at regionals and capped off the season with a 4th place finish at States. For the third year in a row she was named to both All-Conference and All-County team. She was also named Golfer of the Year for Livingston County for the second year in a row. Hannah will be returning for her senior year and will have the opportunity to make another run at the State title along with improving on all of her previous honors.



12 Gabrielle Shipley Hastings Bruce Krueger

Gabrielle, a senior, had an outstanding season in which she was the medalist in sixteen of seventeen competitive rounds and finished second in the other by one shot. Her 18-hole tournament average prior to the State Finals gale force winds was 72.2 with a cumulative total of one under par. Her 9-hole average is 37.1. She was voted unanimous All-OK Gold for the fourth consecutive year and had a conference 9-hole average 4.0 strokes lower than the next best golfer in the conference who is a two-time member of the All-State Team. Gabrielle has won the Regional tournament the past two years. She has played in the State Finals all four years including leading her team to fourth, second and third place finishes the past three years. Her individual finishes at the State Finals were 5th, 7th, 5th and culminated with her winning the D-3 State Finals at Forest Akers - West this year. Gabrielle had been selected to the All-State team for three years.



11 Morgan Smith Mona Shores John Brainard

Morgan is a key component to a very special group of Mona Shores girl golfers. Morgan set the individual school scoring record with an even par 72 at the Greenville Invitational at the Links of Bowen Lake. She had a tournament average of 76.73 placing first at the Greenville Invitational, Ludington Invitational at Lincoln Hills, OK Black Post-Season Tournament at the Meadows (GVSU), and the Ernie Popiel Invitational at Egypt Valley. Morgan finished first eight times, second twice, and third five times out of all the fifteen events Mona Shores participated. Morgan was named first team all conference and medalist for the OK Black Conference for the third year in a row with the top average of 38.43. Morgan was also medalist at regional held at Egypt Valley with a round of 77. She led her team to a third consecutive Division Two State Championship with rounds of 81-79 in very difficult conditions for an individual third place finish at Katke-Cousins. Morgan, a three-sport athlete and All State Division II golf as a freshman and sophomore, had a tournament average of 76.7 this year.



12 Gabrielle Yurik Stoney Creek Tony Lafferty

With her fourth all-state recognition and her inclusion in the three previous super teams, Gabby has been one of the most decorated golfers to come out of the state of Michigan and has enjoyed tremendous success this season both in the classroom as well as on the golf course. Gabby was the medalist in every dual match we played, and in the eleven tournaments she played in this season, she was the medalist in seven of them. A model of excellence and consistency throughout the season, Gabby never placed lower than fourth at any of this year's tournaments. Her season was highlighted by a first place finish at the Oakland County Tournament, shooting the only sub-par round of the day. She continued her season-long dominance by shooting a score of 72 at the regional tournament, qualifying her and her team for the state tournament. It was at this year's state tournament that Gabby culminated her season, and her high school career in stellar fashion. In weather conditions marked by inconsistent winds that would send most searching for cover, Gabby illustrated her trademark determination and perseverance and combined her first day's score of 78 with an even more impressive 75 on day two, to finish with a two-day score of 153. In doing so, she was the only player in the field to post scores in the 70's on both days of competition and managed to turn a four stroke deficit at the end of day one into a four stroke lead to earn medalist honors at the division one state finals. Gabby managed all of these accomplishments while maintaining a 3.992 GPA and earning the academic All State Award. As a result of her stellar play and academic excellence, Gabby will be continuing her studies and her play at Michigan State University next year.

South Christian

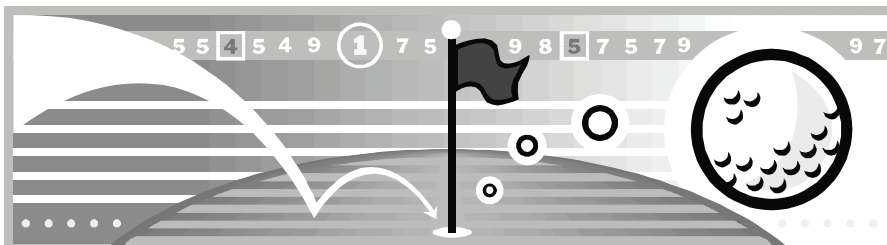

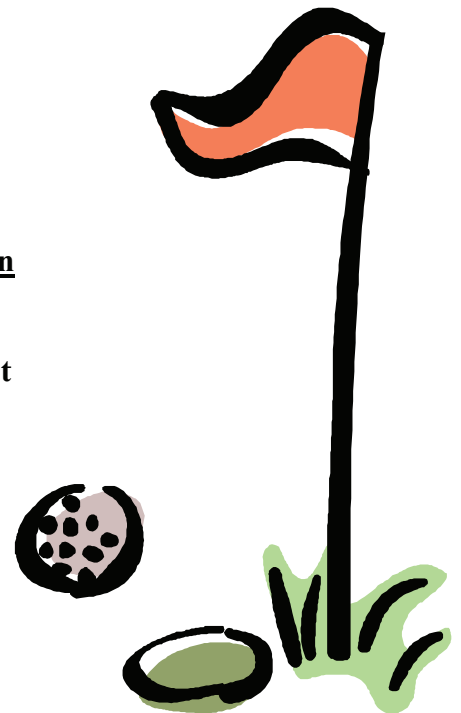

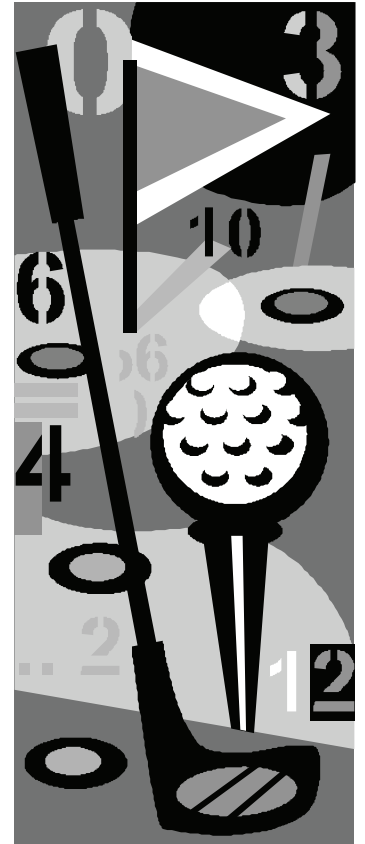
