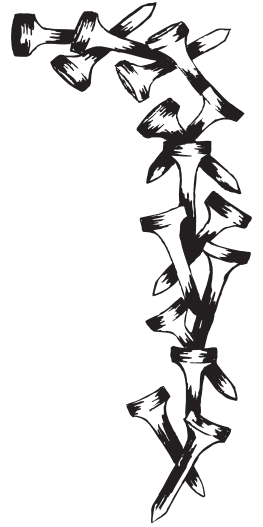
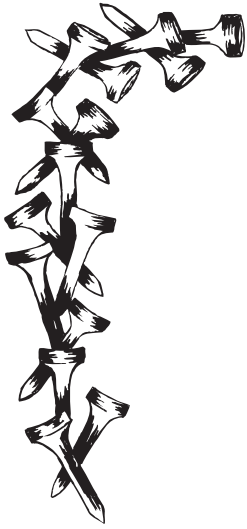

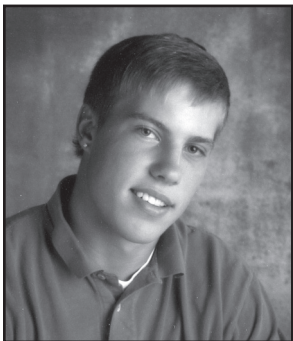


2009 Boys All State Super Team



10 Tommy Conway Brighton Jonathan Wendrick

Tommy, a sophomore, earned his second varsity letter as a sophomore at Brighton and made tremendous strides in his game. His work ethic and love for golf allowed him to take his game to the next level. Tommy had ten top ten finishes in tournament play, which included seven top five finishes. His nine-hole match average was 39.3 and his tournament average was 74.6. Tommy was named First Team All Conference in the Lakes Conference of the KLAA. He also holds the honor of being named Livingston County Player of the Year, and First Team All-Area by the Ann Arbor News. Tommy's season was highlighted by his even par 72 at the Seaholm Invitational where he tied for 1st place. A one under par 71 on the Forest Akers East at the East Lansing Invitational gave him a tie for 2nd place, and his one under par 70 at Regionals allowed him to walk away with medalist honors and a place at the State Finals. At the MHSAA State Finals his score of 74-75 gave him a 3rd place finish. Tommy's consistent play throughout the year helped lead Brighton to one of its best seasons in golf history. Coach Wendrick sees a bright future ahead for Tommy with his game of golf.



11 Jared Dalga Forest Hills Central Paul TenEyck

Jared's junior season was one of the best in school history. Jared started the year by winning medalist honors at the Giant Invitational by firing a 76, his highest score of the year. Jared's strong play continued throughout the spring. He finished as medalist or tied for 1st in nine events. He carded a 72 or lower seven times this year. His overall average for the season was 72.75. Jared's strong play can be attributed to two things: his desire to be the best and his love for the game. Jared's fine play led the Rangers to invitational victories at The Ludington Invitational, Zeeland Invitational, NorthPointe Christian Invitational, Ram Invitational, a Regional Championship, and culminating in Forest Hills Central's first MHSAA State Championship in the schools history. At the State Finals Jared finish tied for 1st and was in a playoff leaving him in 2nd place. Coach TenEyck believes Jared has firmly placed himself among the best golfers in the State of Michigan with his performance on the golf course this year.

Joey finished the season with a tournament average of 71.1 and was low medalist in 13 of 16 tournaments. The first was at Pohlcat where he fired a 69, and beat the entire field by ten shots. He followed up with another 69 at the Traverse City Invitational played at the Grand Traverse Resort. In East Lansing, at Walnut Hills, Joey finished one shot out of first place. At the Traverse City two day, Spruce Run and Wolverine event Joey carded back 68's beating everyone in the field by nine shots. He tied for 1st in Alpena, with a 74 followed by two more 1st place finishes, one in Cheboygan with a 73, and another at Charlevoix Belvedere with a 71. He continued his run of 1st place finishes at Petoskey Bay View firing a 71, and yet another carding a 70 at the Classic in Gaylord. Before heading to District he posted another 1st place at the Cadillac CC firing a 66. Districts were played at the challenging Pohlcat Golf Course where Joey shot a one over par 73. At the Big North Conference Championship Joey carded an impressive 67 clinching first place both in the tournament and in the Big North Conference. Not only did Joey take first in the conference, but he now has the lowest average in the history of the BNC with a 69.5. At Regionals, Joey took first place with a 71, propelling his team to the MHSAA State Finals at the Meadows where Joey shot a 78 on the first day and coming back the second day to shoot a 74. Joey finished tied for sixth with a two day total of 152, just five shots out of first place. Joey capped the season with an average UNDER par 71.06.

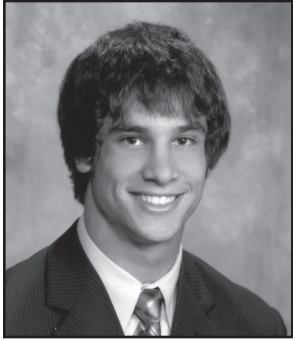


12 Wes Gates

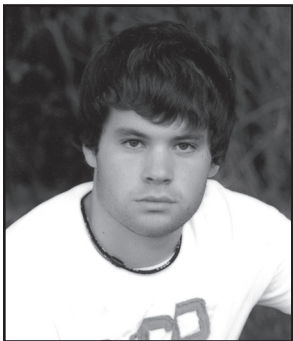

Wes, a senior, had a nine-hole average of 38.5 and a tournament average of 74.8. He was a first team All-Stater in 2008 and has clearly played his way on to the Super Team. Wes has a string of gems on his resume. He was medalist at the East Lansing Spring Invitational at Walnut Hills Country Club. He followed up with Day 1 medalist honors at the Traverse City Central Tee Off Classic. He finished tied for medalist at the 36-hole East Lansing Classic at Forest Akers that featured 200 of the best golfers from around the state. He tied for 2nd at Regionals and at the KLAA conference tournament. He finished 7th at Districts. He was named to the First Team All-Conference, All-District and All-Regional for the third year in a row. Wes capped off this spectacular season with the honor of being the Division 1 Individual State Champion firing a two day total of 148. He is attending Bowling Green University and is a member of the Falcon Golf Team.



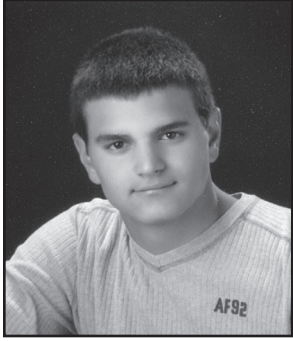
12 Phil Giesecker Saline Debbie Williams-Hoak

Phil, a senior, was a four year varsity player and letter winner. This year, he was a three time medalist in invitationals, a five time medalist in Conference matches and had seven top ten finishes in other invitationals and matches. His year low was a 67 at the Onsted Invitational at The Grande Golf Course. Phil was a unanimous first team SEC All conference for the fourth year and was SEC Conference Player of the Year for the second time in his high school career. Phil was chosen as the Wendy's High School Athlete of the Week in April and in the post season named All-Area Player of the Year by the Ann Arbor News. He finished in the top ten at the MHSAA State Finals the last three years with a tie for 4th place this year, only two shots out of a first place playoff. Coach Williams-Hoak stated, "It was an honor and privilege to have been able to share in Phil's senior year. He had quite a few special moments on the golf course this year and it was very exciting to be part of them. In practice and away from the course, Phil was a role model and a leader, doing everything that was asked of him in a very unselfish manner. His work ethic was unparalleled. Phil was every coach's dream athlete, talented, hard working, a team player and a quality young man." Phil is attending Ohio University and is a member of the Bobcat Golf Team.



12 Chase Olsen White Pigeon Mark Olsen

Chase Olsen, senior, is a three-time All-State selection and was named to the Super Team as a junior. Chase was medalist in all seven dual events, and was medalist in six of the nine tournaments he played. He had two tournament runner-up finishes and a 4th place finish. Chase was medalist at Regionals and the Division 4 MHSAA State Finals where he had to birdie his last three holes to force a playoff on the final day. His nine-hole average is 33.86 and his 18-hole average is 72.0. He finished the 2009 season eight strokes under par. He had 11 top ten finishes in tournament play and was named First Team in the St. Joseph Valley Conference. He tied for 2nd place at his District played at Milham Park Golf Course and went on to win the Regional played at Riverside Country Club. Chase has been the Regional medalist three years in a row and was State Runner-up in the 2008 season. He capped off his senior season with a trip to the MHSAA State finals where he finished 1st playing at Forest Akers East. Chase has been the St. Joseph County medalist all four years. He was also the conference MVP the last three seasons. Chase is very well respected by fellow competitors as well as the opposing coaches. He has an incredible work ethic and love for the game. Upon the conclusion of his high golf season it was announced that Chase was named to the NHSGCA Boys All America team. He is attending Grand Valley State University and is a member of the Lakers Golf Team.



12 Jordan Weinger Farmington Dennis Zaleski

Jordan, a senior and captain of the team, had a nine-hole average of 37.7 and a tournament average of 74.2. He carded twelve top ten finishes in tournament play that included two medalist honors. He tied the 18-hole school record firing a 69 in tournament play. At Districts played at Pontiac Country Club and at Regionals he finished in 9th place. Jordan was a two time Optimist Club Golf Tournament State Champion and a National Tournament Competitor Qualified 2009 posting a score of 67. In 2008 he was named to the All State Team and this year was Farmington High School's Most Valuable player. He also holds the honor of being named to the OAA All Conference Team, Observer and Eccentric All Area Team and All Oakland County Team. Coach Zaleski speaks of Jordan's fine sportsmanship. He also states "Jordan is held in the highest regard by coaches who know him as a player with a great attitude and a gentleman on and off the golf course". Jordan is attending Oakland Community College and is a member of the Raiders Golf Team.



12 Alex Zanetti Orchard Lake St. Mary's Prep Kris Daiek

Alex, a senior, has been a three-year varsity player. His nine-hole average was a 38.7 and his tournament average was 74. He had eight top ten finishes in tournament play. Alex was named to the first team in his conference. He won the highly competitive Catholic League Tournament with a 70 played at the University of Michigan. Alex placed in the top five in every tournament he played, except one, and was medalist in four tournaments this year. Alex finished 4th in the County Tournament, won the District Tournament and finished 4th in the Regional Tournament. He finished his career by birdying three of his last four holes on the second day of the MHSAA State Finals to tie and go on to win the Individual State Championship. He was named to the 2nd Team All County, and the All Area Dream Team. Alex is attending the University of Tampa and is a member of the Spartan Golf Team.

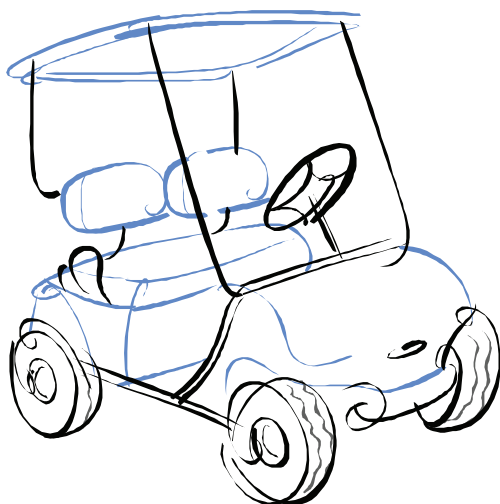
12 Melissa Beurmann Jackson Lumen Christi Mary Stuart

Melissa has led her team in every area for her four years playing at the Varsity high school level. She has been named the All-Area golfer by the Jackson Citizen Patriot every year. She has placed first in eight of the events this year as well as winning in a three hole playoff at the Brighton Invitational and scoring an amazing 69 at East Lansing's invitational at Walnut Hills Country Club. She won every league event she played in and was named to the All League CAAC Red Division team. Melissa finished her golf career at Lumen Christi with an excellent second place finish at the state finals.



11 Devon Compton Rochester Stoney Creek Todd Vince

Devon is a three year letter winner and as a junior is on a mission to become the top player in Michigan and beyond. Devon competed in 16 events and never finished lower then fifth place. In the OAA Red division she was top medalist in 5 of 6 dual matches with an average of 38.4. She was able to shoot an amazing 68 and finish number one in Oakland Counties Division I tournament. "Devon is one of the hardest working athletes I have ever met. She has an unbelievable work ethic and is always working to perfect all aspects of her game. When it all comes together, it is a thing of beauty to watch unfold," said Coach Todd Vince. Her tournament average of 77.4, led her team to States for the second year in a row. Her two day total of 163 placed her in a tie for fourth in the State. Devon was selected for All OAA League honors and has been named to the All Oakland County team. In six league dual meets Devon finished 1st five times. In nine tournaments played this year, Devon finished in the top five every time and was 2nd in four tournaments. Her 2nd place finish at Regionals helped insure Devon's return to States for a third year in a row.





12 Jacqueline DeBoer GR South Christian Rod Van Dyke

Jackie was an outstanding player in the OK Gold Conference this season. She led the OK Gold with the lowest scoring average. She has received 1st team all-conference honors all four years. She received all-state honors her first three years as a member of the varsity golf team. She set a goal of becoming a member of the all state super team her senior year and put forth the extra work during the off-season to recognize this goal. She recorded a scoring average of 77.4 in tournament play and a 38.6 in conference jamboree play. She received medalist honors in four of the seven tournaments. This included medalist honors at both the Division III regional and state finals. Jackie has been an integral part in the success of the South Christian golf program the past four years which included two runner-up state finishes and two state championships. Her even par 72 at regionals gave her medalist honors for the third year in a row. She is also the first individual state champion in the history of South Christian golf when she fired a 2-day total 3 over par 75/74/ 149. Jackie broke the school scoring record as a sophomore, and has re-set the mark lower each year since then, leaving 72 in the record books at South Christian for future Sailor golfers to try to beat. She will continue her golf career at Ferris State University and will be a member of the Bulldog Golf Team.



12 Kim Dinh Midland Dow Frank Altimore

Kim has been a member of the Dow High golf team for the past four years and this season carried a tournament average of 76.8, 18-hole match average of 70.5 and a nine-hole average of 36.6. She has played the #1 position during her entire career at Dow earning her All Conference First team honors all four years. She has also been named MVP of the Saginaw Valley Conference for the past two seasons. Kim has been the medalist at every match and tournament Dow High has played this year including the Flint regional and the Division 2 state meet held at Forest Akers East on the Michigan State University Campus. This was Kim's third year at the finals and saved the best for her senior year. On the second day she came from seven strokes back to win in dramatic fashion. She finished the last three holes with a birdie on hole winning by one stroke with a two day total (83/74) 157. Not only can Kim perform well on the golf course but she is also an outstanding student in the classroom as shown by her 4.0 grade point average and being named valedictorian of the 2010 class at Dow High School. Kim plans to attend the University of Michigan to study engineering and would like to become a member of the Wolverine golf team.

Lindsey has led the Lady Reds Golf team for the past four years. Her senior year was filled with record low scores and championships. She won the Tecumseh invitational, Huron League Pre-Season Jamboree, Huron League Championship, Monroe County Championship, and Regionals. She was leading the Division 3 State Championship by 2 strokes at the end of day one shooting an impressive 73, and finished in runner-up position by 2 strokes after shooting 78 on day 2. Among her many accomplishments this season were 1st team Huron League, 1st team Monroe County, and all region team for the past 4 years. She made her 4th straight appearance as an individual at States. She was voted all Region golfer by the Monroe Evening News for the 2nd year in a row, was elected to the Dream Golf Team for Washtenaw County and voted all County Player of the Year by Ann Arbor.com. She also hold all school records with a low 9-hole average of 36 and an 18-hole round average of just over 74.

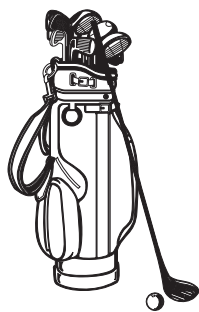


12 Christine Meier

Christine had a dual-match scoring average of 37.0 and was the team medalist four times. Her tournament scoring average was a terrific 73.4 and, of the nine tournaments she competed in, had three 2nd and six 1st place finishes. She capped off a great season by winning her 3rd individual Regional title at Twin Lakes with a score of 73, and the Division 1 State Championship at Forest Akers West with scores of 73-74-157. For her career, Christine is a 3-time individual regional champion and a Division 1 individual state champion. She has led Rochester to three League Championships, four Regional Championships, and two State Championships. She is a 4-time All-League player, 4-time All-Oakland County player, and 4-time member of the All-State Super Team. In four years, Christine never finished outside the top 5 in any tournament she competed in and had finishes of 3rd, T-2nd, T-3rd, and 1st in four state final appearances. Christine has had an unbelievable season and career at Rochester High School and we are very proud of her. The impact she's had on our golf program through her leadership, work ethic, and competitive drive has been tremendous. She will continue her golf career at Michigan State University and will be a member of the Spartan Golf Team.

Brandi, a junior and three year varsity player for Essexville Garber, continues to make very solid improvement to her game. This season she led her team to a Regional Championship which was the first time in Bay County history that a Girls Golf Team won a Regional Championship and advanced to the State Finals. She once again, for the third season, was named to the All Conference 1st Team in the Tri Valley League. Brandi finished the season with a nine-hole scoring average of 37.8 and a tournament average of 76.8. She had fourteen 1st place and two 2nd place finishes during the regular season. Brandi's season was highlighted by her 1st place finish at the Division IV State Finals with a brilliant score of 157. She has a deep passion and dedication for the game of golf along with an extremely committed work ethic.



10 Gabby Yurik Rochester Stoney Creek Todd Vince

Gabby Yurik is a sophomore with nerves of steel. Gabby competed in 16 events this year and was never lower than fourth place. After her first place finish in the Oakland Athletic Associations Red division tournament, with a 72, every player recognized Gabby's talents. With the league strength and level of competition being so high she was able to place 2nd in five dual matches and 4th once. Top four finishes in all seven tournaments played with an average of 77.6 prepared Gabby for a return trip to the State Finals with her teammates from Stoney Creek. Coach Todd Vince stated that, "Gabby has the unique ability to focus and take challenges on the course as opportunities for success. Her ability to think her way around the course and recover from anywhere makes for an exciting round to watch. You never know what she will come up with or do next on the course." Shooting a 78 on the first day at States put Gabby in 2nd place, where she was last year as a freshman. On the second day she was able to improve her score with a 77 and finished 2nd overall at the State tournament. In six League dual matches played, she finished 2nd five times and 4th once. Top four finishes in all seven tournaments played, as well as a 4th place finish at Regionals with a score of 80, led Gabby and Stoney Creek back to States for the second year in a row. After shooting 78 on the first day of States, Gabby came back with a two day total of 155 and finished runner-up for Division I. For the second year in a row Gabby has been selected to the OAA Red Division all league team, as well as the All Oakland County Team.

Roger has coached golf at Coldwater for many years – 25 years with girls and 16 years with boys. His record for the girls is 2660 wins and 1082 losses. During his tenure, the girls have won nine league championships, eight regional championships, and three state championships (1990-2000-2001). Roger also won the boys state championship in 1994 – his rookie season with the boys. Roger had done many things during his coaching years to help high school golf. He has served as President elect, president and past president of the MIGCA for the years 2000-2006. He also runs invitationals and regionals. Roger has served on all state selection committees each fall. Roger has received many awards during his coaching career. In 2006, he was inducted into the MIGCA Hall of Fame. In 2001, he was chosen National Federation Coaches Association Central Section Coach of the Year and Michigan High School Coaches Association Coach of the Year. **MIGCA STATE COACHES OF THE YEAR
2009 BOYS COACH OF THE YEAR**

David Ghareeb

East Grand Rapids

The East Grand Rapids Boys golf program has experienced many great accomplishments over the years but since 2002, it has attained a status equal to the top programs in the state. During that time, the Pioneer golfers have lost a total of four 9-hole matches and in the last six years, have only lost one match by one stroke including a streak of four and one-half years without losing a single 9-hole match and capturing six OK White conference titles. They have won many invitationals and routinely place in the top five, playing predominantly against the top Division I schools in the state. The Pioneers have been equally impressive at the state level winning district championships in 2005 and 2006 and since 2002, won seven consecutive MHSAA regional titles in a row finishing second last year by three strokes. Last year, the Pioneers placed 8th in the MHSAA state finals but prior to that finished 6th, 4th, 1st, 2nd, 4th, and 2nd. Individually, the Pioneer golfers have attained at a high level as well. In the past eight years, East Grand Rapids has had 31 OK White All Conference players, numerous All Area accolades, and 19 All State players recognized for excellence on the golf course. Dave states, "It is truly an honor and a privilege coaching at East Grand Rapids."

2009 GIRLS COACH OF THE YEAR

Rod Van Dyke

Grand Rapids South Christian

Rodney has distinguished himself as the girl's varsity golf coach for the past 14 years. As the Varsity Girls Coach, Rod has enjoyed great success at South Christian. Since starting the program in 1996, Rod has made eleven consecutive state appearances. He has also led his teams to six conference titles, nine regional titles, four runner-up state finishes, and two state championships. In the past five years, Rod has three consecutive OK Gold Conference titles, four consecutive Regional titles, two runner-up State finishes, and two State championships. In the past five years, the South Christian Girls Teams accumulated a record of 234 wins to 29 losses. This past season, the girl's golf team recorded a perfect record in conference and tournament play. The following is a quote from a parent of this Championship Team, "In the classroom and on the course, Coach Van Dyke connects to his players. He has an open-door policy that encourages the students to set high goals and work hard to achieve those goals. It is never easy for a team to come into a season with the Number One ranking, but that was the reality of the South Christian golf team this season. Coach Van Dyke spent valuable time with the team talking about how to balance the pressure of high expectations, and the importance of working hard and practicing smart."

2009 was Paul's 11th season as head coach for the Rangers and certainly his most memorable. The 2009 season truly was a dream season for the Rangers. Paul credits his team's hard work and determination for making this season special. They won their second consecutive conference and regional championships, and made the State Finals for the third year in a row. The team finished first or second in every event they entered this year, including wins at the Ludington Invitational, Zeeland Invitational, NorthPointe Christian Invitational, and Ram Invitational. Their dream season culminated in winning the first golf State Championship for Forest Hills Central.

Division II

Gej Jones

East Lansing

Gej has coached golf for 28 seasons at East Lansing High School. He became the Trojan varsity coach in 1999 for both the boys and girls. Gej's teams have amassed a win loss record of 398/64 in league play. The boys have finished 1st or 2nd place in the league, seven of the last ten seasons, followed by two 3rd place finishes and a 4th. Since 1999, one of his teams has represented East Lansing High School at the MHSAA Finals every year. In those eleven trips to state finals his boys' teams have brought home for East Lansing a 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place finish over Gej's coaching career. In this 2010 season the boys carded fifteen top ten finishes in tournament play. They finished 2nd in their District, 2nd in their Regional, and capped off their season with a 3rd place finish at the MHSAA Finals. When asked, Gej will say what he liked most about coaching is the interaction with the kids. He also enjoys meeting players from around the state and especially spending time with his fellow coaches.

Division III

David Swartout

Jackson Lumen Christi

This was Dave's 25th year coaching the boy's golf team but his first after a thirteen year hiatus following the '95 season. During his first coaching stint his teams won thirteen consecutive conference titles, ten regional titles and ten MHSAA State Championships. During that time he also compiled a dual meet record of 325-36. The 2009 season started off slowly for the team with only one top five finish in their first three tournaments. Trying to find our best 5th and 6th player proved difficult in the beginning, but as the season progressed every single player improved. Eventually the team had a number of top three finishes in their invitational tournaments and a 2nd place finish in the conference. Every player worked long hours on their game at practice and on their own. This type of dedication resulted in this team being as successful as any other team in Lumen Christi's golf history. They turned a good season into a tremendous season by winning the District Championship, the Regional Championship and the Division III State Championship.

Division IV

Mark Olson

White Pigeon

Mark finished his fourth year as head coach and seventh season overall with the White Pigeon varsity golf team. He also served as the assistant coach for three seasons before being the varsity coach. In 2000, even before his assistant coaching job, he started a junior high program that became a strong feeder program for White Pigeon golf. Ten of Mark's junior high players competed at the high school level and went on to play college golf. The success of White Pigeon golf can be attributed to the player's strong work ethic and discipline that included a desire to work hard enough to be the best they could be. In the past four seasons White Pigeon golf has won three St. Joseph Valley League Championships, three St. Joseph County Championships, two District Championships and three Regional Championships. The Chiefs have also made four trips to the MHSAA State Finals which have resulted in four top 10 finishes and three top 5 finishes, including a Runner-up finish in 2009.
