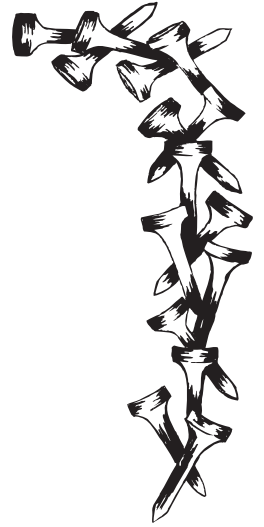
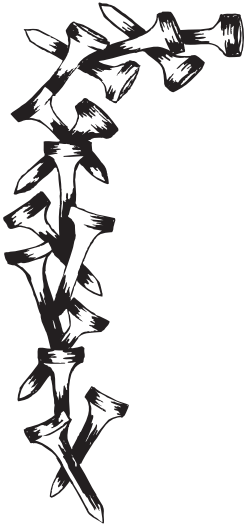

12 Evan Bowser Dearborn Howard Inch

Evan Bowser exemplifies every characteristic that one would want in a high school golfer. His golf accomplishments are many this season - seven 18-hole tournament wins, twelve top ten finishes, and second in the MHSAA State Finals. His career statistics are even more impressive, including twenty career tournament medals. He attacks the golf course like a tireless artist, working his trade every second of the round. Opposing coaches often use him as an example to their own golfers and like to play their young prodigies in his group. More importantly, he is the whole package - golfer, student and person. Having spent time with Evan in the classroom it is clear he has been an outstanding student over his four years at Dearborn.



9 Nick Carlson Hamilton Kevin Arnold

Nick Carlson is a young man with lofty goals and high expectations. Before the season his goals were to win the conference, win the state championship and be one of the youngest at Hamilton High School to earn All-State Honors. During the season Nick was medalist in thirteen of the fifteen events he played including a firing a 71 at the Zeeland East Invitational and a 78 at the wind-swept conference finals played at The Meadows @ GVSU. Nick was runner up at Districts played at Clearbrook Golf Course in Saugatuck. Nick was named medalist at Regionals carding a 74 at Cedar Chase Golf Club in Cedar Springs. Nick capped off his season with a two hole playoff win at the MHSAA Division II State Championship played at Katke Golf Course on the campus of Ferris State University. His two day scores were 71-68/giving him a total of 139. Nick met his goals and surpassed his coach's expectations.



12 Alexander Dombrowski Gaylord Tom Johnson

Alex competed his senior season at Gaylord by being named to the Big North Conference 1st Team for the third consecutive year. He was also the low medalist in the conference for the season. His overall average of 72.4 allowed him to finish in the Top 10 in all sixteen tournaments he played. Those finishes included eight medalist's honors, four second place finishes, and two-third place finishes. His season was highlighted by a new school record of 65 at the Traverse City Invitational and culminated with a 67-73 finish at the MHSAA State Finals, finishing 3rd overall in Division II. Alex's selection to the 2012 All State Super Team is a fitting end to his high school career because of all the time and hard work he has devoted to the game of golf these past four years. He was a four year letter winner at Gaylord High School, the team's MVP and Captain both his junior and senior seasons, and was named to the All-State 1st Team Division II his junior year. The most impressive thing about Alex is his consistency. He completed his last two seasons, playing in 32 tournaments, carding all his scores in the 70's or better. He is a great leader and was always willing to share his knowledge of the game with our younger golfers to help them improve every day.



12 Sean Friel Brother Rice Dan Bumpus

Sean, a four year letter winner on the Brother Rice varsity team, capped off a fabulous career with a stellar senior season. Sean's great play helped propel Brother Rice to an undefeated league season as well as a League, District, Regional, and State championship. His 8 top-ten finishes were highlighted by a 2 under par 70 at Districts, a 2 under par 70 individual title at Regionals, and a 4th place finish at the state tournament with a 148. Sean was a quiet leader during his four years at Brother Rice. His dedication to practice was a fine example for younger players. Sean's never-give-up attitude showed his teammates that every shot counted and that even after a tough hole, he could always come back with a birdie. Sean will play golf at Michigan State University



11 Matt Garland Battle Creek Lakeview Tony Evans

Matt's junior season proved to be a memorable one. The team finished in the top five in each of their thirteen invitationals. They captured a league divisional title for the seventh straight season, Big 16 Conference Champions for the fourth straight year, third straight district title, and just missed winning it all in Division I when they finished as runners up this year by 1 stroke. Matt was a captain of this year's team and helped lead his team throughout the season with strong individual performances on the course. Matt finished in the top ten eleven times this season in tournament play. He was tournament medalist five times. Matt's overall average this season was 75.6. Like most good players and true leaders Matt saved his best for last. Matt fired his best round of the season on the first day of the MHSAA Division I State Finals held at the Meadows at Grand Valley when he carded a three under par 69. He came back the next day and shot an even par 72 winning both days of the state finals and capturing the overall medalist honors with a solid three under 139. Matt is also a leader in the classroom with a GPA that shows he is an outstanding student. He plans to continue his education and golf career after he graduates by attending Northwood University in the fall of 2013.



11 Reed Hrynewich Mona Shores Tom Wilson

Reed has been a three year leader for the Mona Shores Sailors. In his junior season, his scoring average was a 72.5 and he was medalist five times. Highlight victories came at the competitive Traverse City Invitational where he closed with a 69 and the Forest Hills Rangers Invitational also with a 69. In fourteen events he carded an impressive eleven top four finishes and never finished outside of the top seven. Reed is also a leader in the classroom producing an above average GPA. His drive and athleticism allow him to excel in his other sport, hockey. He was named All State in his junior year for his success on the ice. Reed works on his game continually and his work ethic and dedication will bring him success when he starts his college career at the University of Michigan in the fall of 2013.



11 Sam Weatherhead G R West Catholic Andy Weatherhead

Golf has been one of Sam's focus points for as long as his family can remember. He started playing at age two. At age seven he won his first tournament in a twelve and under event. At age eight he had his first hole-in-one and a double eagle. After many more tournament wins Sam busted onto the high school scene by winning his first high school tournament, the prestigious Kent County Classic. He was named Conference Player of the Year and All State after his 9th and 10th grade years. In 2012 during his junior year he won five of the State's best tournaments and then went on to win the MHSAA State tournament and was named to the All-State Team for a third straight year moving up to Super Team then named Mr. Golf. During the past summer Sam was medalist at the Michigan Junior Amateur and qualified for the United States Junior Amateur. For all the great things Sam has done on the golf course they peril in comparison to what an outstanding young man he is. Sam has over 350 hours of community service. He volunteers instruction time with several Junior golf programs and is very active in his church. Sam has committed to play golf for Michigan State University where he will study engineering.



12 Brett White East Kentwood Bill Giarmo

Brett's selection to the 2012 Boy's All-State Super Team represents the culmination of an outstanding high school golf career at East Kentwood High School. Brett was a member of the varsity team all four of his high school years, and a First Team All-State golfer for the past two years. He had a spectacular senior season by finishing with a 37.3 dual match average and a 73.5 tournament average. His season was highlighted by earning District Medalist honors by shooting a career low round of 67 at Braeside Golf Club, and followed this up by shooting a 1 under 70 at Muskegon Country Club to earn Regional Medalist honors. Brett's dedication and hard work earned him OK Red All Conference selection in all four years. He was also an Advance Newspapers "All Area" selection in his sophomore, junior & senior years. He was OK Red Conference medalist his junior and senior years. Throughout his high school career, Brett exhibited great sportsmanship and leadership and was the team captain for the past two seasons, and received three consecutive Team MVP awards. Off the course, Brett was an excellent student, graduating with an impressive GPA. In addition to his All State Golf accolades, Brett earned All-State honors for MHSAA Division 1 Hockey as a sophomore, junior and senior. Brett is currently attending Eastern Michigan University and a member of the Eagles Men's Golf team.

12 Taylor Clark Utica Anthony Adamo

Taylor capped off her senior golf season finishing runner up in the Division I State Finals at Forest Akers Golf Course in East Lansing. Taylor battled the wind and rain for two days falling just one stroke off the leader in a grueling 36 hole tournament. Taylor's achievements over the past 4 years have made her the most accomplished female golfer in Macomb County history. In this past season, Taylor's 18 hole scoring average was 73.4 which helped lead Utica High School to their first Macomb Area Conference Red Division and Regional Team Championship. Taylor's 2012 season accomplishments are Division I MHSAA State Championship runner-up carding a two day total 149. Medalist at the Division I Regional held at Dearborn Country Club posting a 74. Taylor was runner-up at the MAC Red Conference Tournament scoring a 75. She was again medalist at Macomb County Invitational (69) and Lapeer Golf Course and Country Club (70). She finished runner-up at the Knollwood Invitational (70) and And posting a 77 was runner-up at the Forest Lake Country Club Invitational.



11 Pader Her Holt Doug Harkema

Pader had a record setting 2012 season for the Holt Rams. Pader's season began with a 1 under par round in the CAAC Blue opener setting a school record for 18 holes. This was a glimpse of what the junior's season would look like. She won eight events this season, had four runners-up finishes and finished in the top five of every event. Pader's tournament resume is very impressive. She shot another school record 71 on the Wolverine in Traverse City to win her first tournament of the year. She backed it up with a top five finish on Spruce Run. Pader then shot 73 for a runner-up finish at the Lakewood Invitational, shot another 73 at Oak Pointe Country Club to finish 3rd in the Bill Miller Invitational, and rounded out the beginning of her season with a runner-up finish at the Pioneer Invitational played at the University of Michigan golf course. Pader's record setting season continued in CAAC Blue League play. She won or shared 1st place in the last five league events. She set the school record for nine holes twice in this stretch shooting a two under par 34 at Royal Scot and then reset the record with a three under 33 at Eldorado. Pader finished off her CAAC Blue season with a win at the League Championship shooting a winning score of 73 at Walnut Hills Country Club. She also won the league point's race as an individual. She finished the six event league season at an incredible five under par. This is particularly impressive considering that there is another MIGCA Super Team Player in the same conference. Pader finished off the season as she started it. She won the Titan Invitational at Jackson Country Club by resetting the school record, this time shooting a two under par 70. She then won the Ernie Popiel Invitational at Egypt Valley Country Club shooting a fine score of 75. Pader entered MHSAA tournament play with three straight big wins! She continued her outstanding play by shooting a very nice one over par round at Regionals and won her second consecutive individual Regional Title that helped send the Holt Rams to their 9th consecutive MHSAA State Finals as a team. Pader closed out her stellar junior campaign with a third place finish at Division I State Finals



12 Hailey Hrynewich Mona Shores John Brainard

Hailey finished her senior year with a first place finish at Regionals and a tie for first at the Division II State Finals. She was the OK Black Conference leader with an impressive under par average of 35.1. Highlight rounds for her were a 3 under par 70 at the Meadows of Grand Valley State University and a 4 under par 32 at Lincoln Golf Club. Hailey carried a 75.3 scoring average. In fifteen events she finished first seven times and had a total of fourteen top three finishes. Hailey is also a leader in the classroom with an outstanding GPA. Her excellent work ethic and strong dedication will bring her great success when she begins her college golf career at Ohio University in the fall of 2013.



12 Aya Johnson Muskegon Catholic Central Jim Hegedus

Aya's 2012 high school golf season was nothing short of spectacular. Coming off an impressive showing this summer, Aya continued her success on and off the golf course this fall. She has been a member of the All-State Team the last three years and has finished in the top ten of the State Tournament all four years of her high school career. Not only is she one of the most well recognized golfers to come from the west side of the state, her demeanor on and off the course make her a favorite playing partner among her peers. Aya won all her dual matches and was the medalist in 9 out of 10 tournaments this season. Her most impressive victory came at the prestigious Lober Classic in Traverse City firing a tournament record of 67/65 132 to beat the entire field by eleven strokes. Her only loss came at the West Bloomfield's Next Tee Girls Golf Invite where she still shot even par and finished third in a field of ninety-six players. She travelled all over the state to face the best competition and came out of it boasting a 799-2 record. This was a very impressive feat for a girl who turned seventeen in the middle of October. Fall golf in Michigan brings out the best, and Aya continually showed her determination and ability to play well in the face of adversity. Shooting a 73 at the Ludington Invitational in pouring rain and wind to beat the field by six strokes was just the beginning. She won Regionals by shooting a 77 in cold, windy conditions, and Aya wrapped up her stellar senior season in exciting fashion by winning the Division 4 State Finals at the challenging Forest Akers West. After the first day she was three shots back, and her trademark perseverance left her on the putting green until dark. Day Two came and she birdied three of the last six holes to shoot a 73 and force the playoff that she won on the first hole. Her second day score was the lowest of any Division in the state that day. She finished the season with an 18 hole scoring average of 73.0. Aya posted one of the best seasons in the history of Michigan Girls Golf and did so while maintaining a near perfect GPA at North Muskegon High School. Her light hearted personality, infectious smile, dedication to being the best on the course, and commitment to excellence in the classroom will make her a huge success in whatever she does. Aya has chosen to continue her stellar play and performance in the classroom at the University of Wisconsin as a part of the Badge Golf Team.

Elle is a terrific young lady who has accomplished a great deal in her three years of high school golf. Elle has been very active in competitive athletics. As a freshman, Elle played four sports, volleyball, golf, basketball and soccer. As a freshman, she was our team MVP, made First Team All-Conference and finished fifth at the State Tournament while being named First Team All-State. As a sophomore, Elle was again team MVP, First Team All-Conference and All-State. She also won the Conference Tournament, the Regional and State Tournaments. She was named the Lansing State Journal's "Player of the Year" and was named to the MIGCA Dream Team. As a Junior Elle again was named team MVP, First Team All-Conference and First Team All-State. She again won the Regional and the Individual state championships, while leading her team to a third place finish. She was again named All-State and a Dream Team member. Elle won nine events during the season, including a course record 65 at Willow Wood Golf Club, smashing the previous record by four strokes. She opened the league season carding a 68 at Grand Ledge Country Club. During the summer, Elle made it to the round of 16 in the Michigan State Amateur and finished ninth out of ninety at the State G.A.M. event. Her high school season average was 73.8 strokes for 18 holes. After being a 3 year Captain of the Bulldogs' Golf team, Hannah went on to finish 4th place at the State Tournament this year and was selected for the fourth consecutive year to the All-Conference team. In fact, in her senior year Hannah was undefeated in conference play and finished in first place for the 3rd year in a row at our conference championship tournament. Hannah continued to dominate play during the season. She shot even or under par for six of the twelve tournaments she played. Even more impressive, she was medalist in seven out of the twelve tournaments. And for those five tournaments that she was not medalist she finished in the up four on the board. By staying focused and dedicated she was able to shoot an average of 35.1 for 9 holes, and 73.4 for 18 holes, setting an all-time school record for the Brighton Bulldogs. A strong leader, always willing to help her teammates, and a perfectionist on the course, are just a few attributes that have led to her Bulldog success here in Brighton. Jacqueline, a junior led Lansing Catholic to its third straight MHSAA State Championship. In all league matches this year, she was the medalist all but one match where she took second. In our match against Stockbridge, she had a hole-in-one and set a course record of 30 on Sept. 13th. She had an outstanding 9 hole average of 35.9. In our 18 hole invitationals and league tournament, she was the medalist five times and finished second twice. At the league tournament, she set a course record 68 at Wheatfield Valley Golf Course finishing first overall in the CAAC White Division League. Her 18 hole average was a stellar 74.8. Playing in cold, sleet and windy conditions at regionals, she fired a 76 and finished tied for first. At the MHSAA State Finals at Forest Akers West, Jacqueline finished tied for first place shooting 78 on day 1 and a fabulous 75 on day 2 for a two day total of 153. Jacqueline has been All League for three years and to date she has been All Area, Lansing State Journal Dream Team and All State the past two years.
