12 Steven Barbour East Grand Rapids David Ghareeb



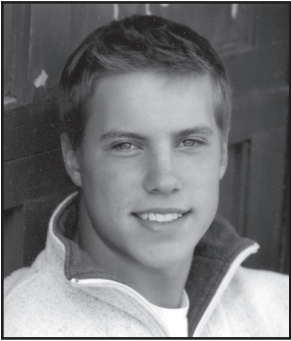
Steven Barbour had an outstanding 2010 golf season. As captain of the East Grand Rapids golf team, Steven finished in the top ten in every invitational this year highlighted by his 2 under par 70 at the OK White post season tournament. In matches, Steven was equally impressive leading the Pioneers to another conference championship his third in four years. As a four-year starter at East, Steven attained many accolades including being named all-conference for four years, all-area for four years, all state for four years and reaching the pinnacle this year achieving Super Team status. Steven has been a staple of the East Grand Rapids golf team serving as a leader to the younger players modeling impeccable behavior both on and off the course. His coach states that “it is a pleasure to coach a young man that consistently plays the game with honor and integrity” he will be sorely missed. Steven is currently attending the University of Michigan.

10 Evan Bowser Dearborn Howard Inch



Finals concluded a fantastic finish to a great season - scoring 4 under par in the state finals! This fantastic score included under par rounds on both days of the state finals - and also included an under par round in the regional finals. This season, Evan shot 7 under par rounds, was medalist in three multi-team tournaments, and had 10 top ten finishes! More importantly, Evan consistently demonstrates all of the positive characteristics of an all-state golfer. His attitude, demeanor, sportsmanship, on-course behavior, and academics exemplify the good things about a MHSAA all-state golfer. In closing, I have to give Evan Bowser the highest compliment that a coach can give - I would be proud to have Evan as my own son!

12 Jared Dalga Forest Hills Central Paul TenEyck



Jared was a four year varsity letter winner at Forest Hills Central. He was all-conference all four years. He was honorable mention All-State as a freshman, and was selected to the Super Team as a sophomore and junior. Jared's senior season was sensational. His tournament average was 70.83. Jared was medalist 10 times, and finished in the top ten 16 times, including a 5th place finish at the Division I State Finals. Jared finished the season 9 under par. He shot under par 8 times. His highest score was 73. Jared was a senior captain for the Division 1 State Finals Runners-Up Team. He is attending Eastern Michigan University and is a member of the Eagle Golf Team.

11 Nick Dennis Brother Rice Dan Bumpus



Nick Dennis has had a profound impact on Brother Rice Golf since his freshman year. Playing exhibition in the first match of the season, a playing competitor of a rival school approached Nick's coach after the match and said, "You'd be crazy not to play this kid." Ever since, he has been a team leader both on and off the golf course. He is a tireless worker who spends countless hours practicing and improving his game. Nick had a spectacular junior season. He showed great consistency with his numerous high finishes. Nick earned All-Catholic League honors and had six top five finishes. His tournament average was the lowest in Oakland County. Highlights of his season include a first place finish by four shots at the Country Club Classic, a second place 69 at the Regional, and a sixth place finish at MHSAA State Finals with a 75-69. Nick plans on playing at Loyola University in Chicago.





12 Joey Garber Petoskey Chad Loe



Joey, for the second year in a row, averaged under par for the 2010 season. Joey averaged an impressive 70.9 with par being 71.5. Joey was medalist in 15 of 17 tournaments, and finished in the top ten all 17 times. Joey finished in first place in the Big North Conference for the second year in a row. He took 2nd in one tournament by shooting par and only lost by one stroke. The only other tournament Joey did not finish first in, he was tied for 7th and 3 shots out of first-place after the first day of competition during the state finals. With an impressive second-day 68 at Forest Acres West, Joey closed his high school career with a State Championship in Division II shooting a two day total of 142, beating the rest of the field by 4 strokes. Joey has had an impressive season, and his accomplishments will be hard to surpass anytime soon. Yet it is his leadership skills, character as an individual and respect for the game of golf that will leave a lasting impression on his teammates, his school, and his community.

12 Trevor Grigg Northville Matthew Stetson



Trevor has been First Team All-State for the past two years and he just completed his best year of the three. He has collected every honor possible including: All-Area Player of the Year, All-Conference, and All-State. His 73.6 18-hole scoring average speaks for itself, but what is most impressive about Trevor is that he always played his best golf at the biggest events. He won the Holiday Inn Express (Birmingham Seaholm) Tournament at Orchard Lake Country Club with an incredibly stacked field. He finished second at the East Lansing Invitational at Walnut Hills Country Club, only finishing behind Mr. Golf 2009, Joey Garber. At the East Lansing Classic Tournament on Forest Akers East, Trevor was once again medalist, shooting 69, with a deep field. At the conference, district, and Regional tournaments he finished 3rd then capped off his glorious career with a 69 on the second day of the state tournament to finish in an overall tie for 6th. Trevor's resume reads like a Super Team Golfer, if not a Mr. Golf candidate. Trevor, with his 3.95 GPA, is headed to the University of Michigan to study Engineering.

9 Reed Hrynewich Mona Shores Tom Wilson



Reed, a freshman, was OK Black All-Conference and All-Area. In tournaments, he was medalist three times, 2nd three times and 3rd three times. Reed had 11 top five rounds and 14 top ten finishes. He was 3rd in Districts, 2nd in Regionals and 6th overall at the State Finals with two even par rounds of 72. Playing top flight tournaments on quality courses, Reed had a season average of 74.85. His work ethic has enabled him to excel in academics while playing golf at an elite level. Because of his outstanding character he is respected by school staff, fellow students, competitors and his teammates. As a coach and teacher for decades, I find Reed to be one of the finest young men I have been associated with.

9 Francesco Ruffino Birmingham Seaholm Leon Braisted III



Francesco had a great year as a freshman. He finished in the top five in every tournament he participated in and had a scoring average of 75. He placed second at the MHSAA Division II State Tournament on the West course at MSU with a score of 146, was medalist in three tournaments, and had five 3rd place finishes. In dual matches he was medalist five times. His 9-hole average was 37.5. He was named to the O.A.A. Blue Division All-League as well as a scholar athlete and won both OAA League meets He was tied for first at the annual Holiday Inn Express tournament with a score of 1 under 71. He was medalist at Regional held at Huron Meadows Golf Course. He placed second at the MHSAA State Finals held. He also has the honor of receiving the Pete Green Most Valuable Player Award and it is the first time in the history of this award that it was given to a freshman.

12 Devon Compton Rochester Stoney Creek Todd Vince



Devon Compton has set the bar high for future Stoney Creek golfers by completing an outstanding season and career. Devon started the 2010 season as medalist in the first two tournaments. Consistently, she remained in the top three in all but three tournaments or matches for the season. To cap off a remarkable career, Devon finished second at the regional tournament, then shot her way into a first place tie at 77 on the first day of the state tournament. On day two, she finished tied for first place after shooting a 73, for a total of 150. Devon won a playoff hole to become medalist in Division I. Devon's resiliency has allowed her to develop the skill and ability to compete at the upper level of golf. This year marks the fourth year she was selected as All City, All League, and All County. She was selected All State as a 10th grader and to the All State Super team as a junior and senior. Devon has accomplished her goal by playing the best she can on every given day.

12 Molly Esordi Grosse Ile Jim Bennett



Molly is a senior captain of the Grosse Ile Golf Team. As a captain, Molly provided excellent leadership and was an excellent role model for the young Grosse Ile Team. Molly was usually the first person to practice and one of the last to leave. Her work ethic inspired her teammates to continue to improve. Molly played in 11 tournament rounds during the year. She had four 1st place finishes and four 2nd place finishes, leading her team to five 1st place finishes and four 2nd place finishes. Molly was the team leading scorer in every event except the regional tournament, where she was second. Over the last four years Molly has been able to lower her average by 30 strokes! She went from not breaking 100 as a freshman to a career best 68 in her conference championship this year. She has been a competitor at the State Finals in each of her four years of high school, finishing in fourth place this year. Her career, as a Grosse Ile golfer, is one of the best the school has ever had. She will truly be missed next year by her teammates and also by her coach.

12 Chelsea Guoynes Traverse City Central Lois McManus



Chelsea overcame a broken arm her freshmen year to take the number one position for her next three seasons and has four years of Varsity letters to her credit. She has been the #1 player in the Big North Conference for three consecutive years. She was named to the All State Team for the past two years and to the Super Team her senior year. She has finished 7th, 3rd and 3rd at State Championships. Chelsea played in fourteen 18-hole tournaments this season and finished seven as medalist and three as runner up. She birdied the first hole of a sudden death play-off at Regionals this season to take medalist honors. This was her second consecutive medalist win at Regionals. She was in the lead after the first day of State Finals with a 79 and finished 3rd overall leading the Trojans to a second place finish. She has been selected for the All-Region Dream Team for four years and has been Captain for the last three years.

12 Brittany Haight Otsego Matt Rayman



Brittany's love for the game of golf and her own personal goals inspired her to convince her friends to play and her school to create a Lady Bulldog Golf Team. Brittney has been All-Conference, All-County, and All-State for the last three seasons and in her senior year named to the MIGCA Super team. Capturing the medalist honors at the Division IV State Championship makes her the first golfer in Otsego history to achieve that honor. Brittany has been a regular at the golf course since she was very young. It was no surprise to those who know her well and who have watched her for so long that she would capped off a brilliant high school career with a state championship. Though quiet and humble by nature, through lofty dreaming and a genuine love of the game, Brittany has earned personal bragging rights for a lifetime. The very existence of Otsego's Girls Golf Team itself she now leaves to others as her legacy.

12 Mariah Massa**Holt****Doug Harkema**

Mariah Massa had a fabulous senior golf season. She led the Holt Rams to a Capital Area Activities Blue Division Championship, a third straight Regional Championship and a third place finish at the Division I State Finals held at Eagle Crest Golf Course in Ypsilanti. Mariah carded seven tournament wins in 2010: Both CAAC League tournaments, the Greenville Invitational, the Titan Invitational, The D1 Regional at Blythefield Country Club and tied for first place at the state finals shooting 77 on Day 1 and a beautiful 73 on Day 2 for a total of 150 before being beat in a playoff. She also placed in the top 10 in 18 tournaments this season. Mariah was named the Lansing State Journal Player of the Year for the 2nd straight season. Mariah is also a member of the varsity tennis team at Holt. She is in National Honor Society and has been on four straight All State Academic teams. Mariah plans to go to Michigan State University and be a member of the Spartan Golf team.

10 Kelsey Murphy**Plymouth****Chris Moore**

Kelsey Murphy has set every individual record at Plymouth High School in her first two years. She has also led the team to set team scoring records as well as earning the teams first ever trip to the state finals. As a freshman last year, Kelsey earned All-State honors and followed up that great season with even a better season this year. She was medalist in eight of the nine dual matches during the 2010 golf season. Kelsey earned medalist honors in five invitationals/tournaments she played in this season against some of the top golfers in the state. She won our conference tournament this year for the second year in a row. She earned all conference and all area first team for the second year in a row. She finished 4th at the regional tournament held at Washtenaw and she finished tied for 5th at the State tournament firing an opening round of 80, followed by a 76 on the second day. She not only excels on the course but in the classroom as well, with a 3.91 G.P.A. She is committed to continually improve all aspects of her game to remain one of the top golfers in the state of Michigan.

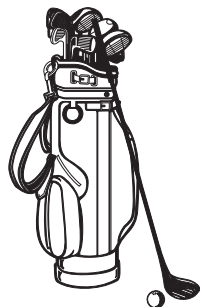


Rosalie is a four year varsity player at Rochester. After making All State as a sophomore and a junior, Rosalie was determined to make this her best season yet. She had a dual match scoring average of 38.8 and finished as medalist in four out of seven matches. Her tournament average was 77 and she never finished outside of the top five in the regular season. She took medalist honors twice, finished 2nd three times and 4th two times. Rosalie also finished 4th at the Twin Lakes Regional with a score of 77 and tied for 8th place at the Division I State Finals with a two day total of 161 (80-81). She has been named to the All-League four times and holds the record for the lowest combined score in the two OAA Red League meets this season. She was named to the All-Oakland County Team three times and to the MIGCA All State Team twice. She has been a member of the Rochester Regional Championship team three times and another Rochester team had that took runner-up honors. During four years of State Finals she finished 9th, 11th, 6th and tied for 8th this year. Rosalie excels in the classroom carrying a 3.96 and as captain of her team her coach recognizes her as an excellent leader.

After a great season Gabby is determined to improve her game and come back as a stronger contender next year.



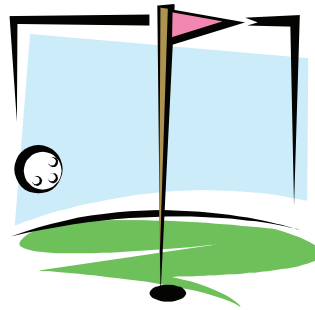

Art has been coaching golf at West Bloomfield for the last 40 years. During that time, he has established himself not only as a great golf coach with unquestioned integrity and ethics, but also as a strong supporter and activist in high school golf at the State and National level. Art was a founding father and first president of the MIGCA. Since that time, he has continuously served as a member of the MIGCA's Executive Committee, and has served as the National Chairman of Golf for the National High School Athletic Coaches Association. Art was named MIGCA National Coach of the year nominee in 1982, 2004 and 2010. Art's West Bloomfield teams have enjoyed great success in the past forty years he has coached them. 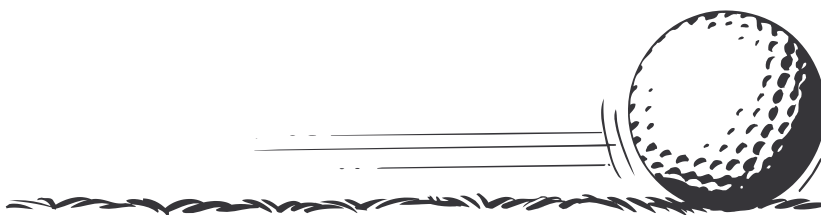

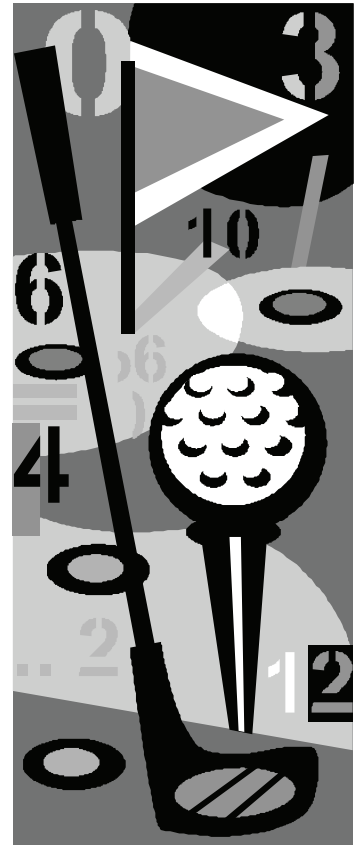

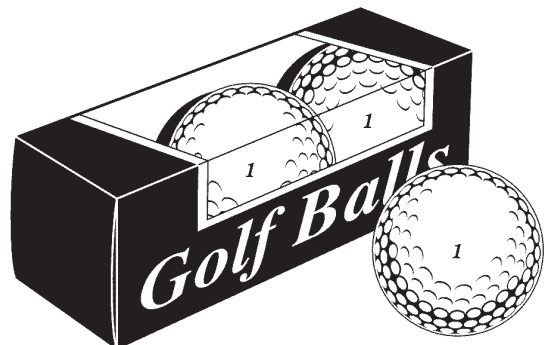
