

Fancy Copper Rosette

Using a bottle or tall body gourd, students will learn step by step how to create this beautiful vessel. They will use stick and burn to accelerate the process of the design and execute a three-dimensional carving technique creating a delicate and elegant rosette. They will work on beveling the contour of each petal of the rosette giving it depth and dimension. They will also work on stippling; Instructor will demonstrate the use of the patinas and Gourd Master acrylic paints with translucent metallic powders to give the vessel an ancient and metallic look. Finishing up, they will learn to inlay copper wire to accentuate the curvature and detail of the rosette. Students will finish all the carving, but they will leave with all the instruction to finish it at home

The instructor will provide: Step by step written instructions and pattern.

Precious Morning Glory

Join artist/ instructor Rosario Wilke in this fun carving class. You will create this beautiful, simple but elegant and contemporary sculpture. You will carve in simple steps, a rustic morning glory as a center of the design, cutting off the center of the flower to lighten the look of the entire design. Also, you will execute a series of different textures in a chronological order, all around the morning glory, building down layers dancing around the center of the design, creating two layers of textures mimicking a skirt, giving the illusion of a double layer and adding interest and depth. Using Gourd Master metallic acrylic paints, you will paint the morning glory and the different layers of the sculpture adding color and richness. Last but not least, you will add a large glass bead to the center of the flower and inlay copper wire, framing around the morning glory's background and flowing along and around between the two layers of carving, harmonizing the design. Also, you will add some glass beads as embellishment giving it an elegant finishing touch. Students will finish all the carving and add the paint and embellishments at home.

The instructor will provide: Written instructions, complete wooden stand, all glass beads embellishments.




