Old Business: A) Mary Betzolt and Ron Elardo expressed their concerns over the Ground Guys moving into their neighborhood and parking their trucks, trailer, and equipment on the road thus creating a very dangerous situation for traffic in the subdivision. Brush piles and debris continue to grow with outside refuse from their clients. They have violated multiple township ordinances. They also stated that the Ground Guys are devaluing property with their business operating illegally in their neighborhood.

They also stated that they have no business permit and are working outside of their house. They stated that it is a noise issue and traffic impedance. Mr Elardo informed the Hansons to talk with Marie at the township office. Adrian Township Building Inspector David Rincon, will go out to the Henson's residence on Friday, October 1st to inform them that these issues are to be addressed and will revisit them on Monday, October 4th to make sure that they have followed through with these requests to avoid citations.

B) Dave Rincon presented the International Property Maintenance Code Book to the planning commission in an effort to further communicate with township citizens the protocols, rules, and laws of building codes and property maintenance requirements.
