## New York Thoughts

I was reading some pew research statistics today about Christianity in NYC. The numbers said that 58 percent of the people that answered the questions they asked considered themselves as Christian. I think that number is definitely inflated, but more staggering is the fact that 32 percent said they attend a religious service on a weekly basis while another 32 percent said they never attend one. That means 26 percent that say they are Christians never attend church. How about this 20 percent say they pray and study scripture at least once a week, while 63 percent say they never study scripture or pray.
