This will arrive in your mailboxes as we are turning the corner from being in the midst of Lent to preparing for Holy Week and Easter Sunday. The earth is turning right along with us as flowers are beginning to peek out in the desert and the mornings are warming up.

During the third week of Lent, we heard Jesus' story about a fig tree that was not producing fruit (Luke 13:6-9). The vineyard owner wanted to cut the tree down, but the gardener suggested creating some space around the trunk and adding nutrients. In my sermon that week, I invited our congregation to consider some questions:

In what ways is our congregation a tree that is not bearing fruit?

Who do we need to ask for help in order to produce fruit?

What kinds of new relationships do we need to form with unexpected people?

What transformation or changes might result in a flourishing tree?

What would that look like for the community around us?

Even as we look for ways to grow and transform, it is also good to remember the ways we are hearing and responding to God's call. At the beginning of Lent, we set a goal of \$400 in special offerings to ELCA World Hunger and 40 pounds of food for the UA Campus Food Pantry. Just halfway through Lent, Our Saviour's members have given over \$1,500 to ELCA World Hunger. The altar in Koch Chapel is surrounded by gifts of food. Amazing! Additionally, we support many local food ministries through our Endowment Fund, annual mission support, and weekly food donations.

May we continue to work for a world where all have the nutrients they need to thrive and bear fruit. God continue to bless you in this season of Lent as we prepare for the journey to the cross and new life in Christ.

VERY IMPORTANT SPECIAL CONGREGATIONAL MEETING! On Sunday, April 3rd -<u>immediately</u> following the service there will be a short congregational meeting to secure your permission to sell the recently bequeathed townhouse which belonged to Lois Olsrud. As per our constitution, any property owned by the church needs approval of a quorum of the congregation before it can be sold. We need all of you to attend this special meeting!

In keeping the health and safety of our more vulnerable parishioners in mind, after reviewing the current Covid information for our county, council voted to move to Phase II of our Covid guidelines. We will maintain spacing and sanitation protocols and encourage wearing facemasks, but will leave it to your personal discretion. We will continue to monitor and readjust our level of care as appropriate.

We are also going to return to using "pew cards" as a way of taking attendance rather than the sign -in sheets. Please fill out these cards so we have your information in case we need to contact you. It also gives you a place to request information, pastoral call, etc.

We ask that you remember the people of Ukraine as they endure the invasion of Russia and the atrocities of war. There will be a concert in our sanctuary of Friday, April 1 at 7 pm (flute, piano, and classical guitar) to benefit the humanitarian needs of the people of Ukraine. This will be open to the public, so please invite your friends and neighbors to attend. Proceeds will be directed to the ELCA Disaster Response Fund/Ukrainian refugee assistance.

And finally, thank you for your faithful support of our mission here at Our Saviour's. Our budget line looks "healthy" at this point in the year.
