In Memoriam: Heidi Gerrish



We lift up in prayer the friends and family of Heidi Gerrish. Heidi died at the scene of an automobile accident Saturday morning, May 21, 2022, while traveling to her sister Julie's graduation from Pacific Lutheran Theological Seminary. Also in the car were her friend Justin, and her brother and sister-in-law, Stephen and Katherine, who were all injured in the head-on collision with a driver going the wrong way on the freeway. Those three have varying severe injuries requiring surgeries and extensive care. The family requests prayers for everyone involved in the accident, as their outcomes become clearer.

Heidi was a board member of the University of Arizona Lutheran Campus Ministry, and worked with Lutheran Social Services of the Southwest as Communications Coordinator in the Fund Department. She and her family are well-known to many in the synod and very active in congregation, synod, and churchwide ministries.
