OPEN RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. ENTRY DEADLINE IS THE LAST SUNDAY OF JULY.
- 2. Only Official Northern District Fair Entry Forms will be accepted.
- Entries may be mailed to: Northern District Fair PO Box 131 Cadillac Michigan 49601; or they may be dropped off at the Fair Office on the last Saturday and Sunday of July, from from 2:00 to 5:00 pm. Online entries can be made at: NorthernDistrictFair.FairEntry.com
- 4. All entries must be paid in full at the time of entry or they will not be accepted.
- All Exhibitors will be given ONE Exhibitor's Pass, which will allow free access to the fairgrounds each day. This pass will not allow entry to the Grandstand events or the Carnival. The Northern District Fair will not replace lost or stolen passes.
- 6. No more than one entry will be accepted from any one Exhibitor in any one class, unless noted in the Fairbook.
- 7. Competition is open to all residents of the State of Michigan. No out-of-state entries permitted, unless approved by the Fairboard prior to entry deadline.
- 8. During the Fair, the Superintendents of each department will have the ultimate authority to disqualify or remove any exhibit that they deem unworthy, or for any rule violation.
- 9. Exhibitors who wish to protest or appeal a placement must do so in writing within 10 days from the close of the Fair.
- 10. Exhibitors must have their Civic Center exhibits in place no later than 7:00 pm Sunday. The Civic Center will be open Saturday afternoon, and Sunday afternoon for entries. Times to be posted in the Events section of the Fairbook.
- 11. All exhibits, both Civic Center and Animal, shall remain in place at the Fairgrounds until the last Sunday of Fair. Early removal of any exhibit shall mean all monies earned will be forfeited by the Exhibitor. EXCEPTION: Market Animals may be released early for processing.
- 12. All animal exhibitors MUST be present to show their own animals.
- 13. The Northern District Fair Association will not be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any animals exhibited, or for damage or destruction to any article of any kind that is entered in the Fair. Each exhibitor will be responsible for any injury that may be occasioned to any person by any animal owned or exhibited by that person, and they shall indemnify the Northern District Fair Association against all claims or injury occasioned by any animal owned or exhibited by him, or arising from any negligence of the person in charge of that exhibit.
- 14. ALL open and youth exhibitors, parents and/or chaperones of youth exhibitors are expected to be properly attired while on the Fairgrounds. Shirts, pants or shorts, and shoes shall be worn at all times. Absolutely no bare feet, swimwear, or other inappropriate clothing will be tolerated. Violators may be asked to leave the grounds.
- 15. The Civic Center will be closed all day Monday while judging takes place.
- All animal exhibitors must adhere to the Michigan Department of Agriculture and Rural Development (MDARD) health regulations. Visit www.Michigan/gov/MDARD for more information.
- 17. Premium Checks must be cashed within 30 days of the end of Fair.
- 18. NO PERSON UNDER EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS OF AGE WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS AFTER ALL DEPARTMENTS AND THE MIDWAY ARE CLOSED FOR THE NIGHT, EXCEPT THOSE IN THE COMPANY OF THEIR PARENT/LEGAL GUARDIAN.
- 19. The sale, use, or possession of alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, or drugs is

forbidden by Law on Wexford County property.

20. Absolutely no weapons, either real or toy, will be brought onto or sold on the grounds of the Northern District Fair. Violators will be immediately removed and will be subject to action by the local law enforcement. A weapon shall include, but is not limited to: guns, knives, blow guns, slingshots, pellet guns, paintball guns.

DEPARTMENT 11 -- OPEN CHICKENS

SPECIFIC RULES

- 1. Only Official Northern District Fair Entry Forms will be accepted.
- 2. Entries are due no later than the last Sunday in July.
- 3. The entry fee is \$1 per bird, and is due with your entry.
- 4. All exhibitors are required to feed, water and clean under their cages at least twice per day. Failure to take care of your animals and exhibit area in a satisfactory manner may result in the loss of premiums due, if any.
- 5. ALL poultry entered MUST be Pullorum tested ON ENTRY DAY prior to entry into the barn. Testing is provided by the Northern District Fair, and is available from 8:00 am until Noon on entry day. No bird will be allowed in the barn before they are tested! Only those birds entered will be tested at no charge. Exhibitors wishing to have extra birds tested will be required to pay \$2 per bird. Pigeons, waterfowl, and doves are exempt from testing.
- 6. Birds showing symptoms of disease or illness will not be permitted to remain on the grounds. This includes, but is not limited to: fowl mites, severe leg mites, respiratory/nasal discharge.
- 7. Exhibitors may advertise their birds for sale only AFTER the judging has been completed.
- 8. Judging will be in accordance with the current edition of the Standard of Perfection. The Judge's decisions shall be final.
- 9. Exhibitors may only enter one bird per class.
- 10. Birds shown in Open may not also be shown in Youth.
- 11. All waterfowl MUST be legbanded by the Exhibitor prior to entry. This is for identification purposes only.
- 12. Exhibitors provide their own feed and water dishes, as well as their own feed. Sawdust for under cages is provided by the Northern District Fair. Please make sure that the water dishes are attached firmly to the cages so they are not dumped.
- For the safety of your animals, the Small Animal Barn will be locked overnight. Barn hours will be posted on entry day.
- 14. Per MDARD Regulations, absolutely no transport cages, boxes or cartons shall be left inside the barn during the Fair.

- 4. Copy of CURRENT coggins must be sent with entry.
- 5. Stalls must be cleaned daily. Periodic checks will be done for stall cleanliness and animal condition.
- 6. Horses must have water at all times and be fed no later than 9:00p.m.
- 7. No horse shall be brought in to replace another horse for any reason.
- 8. Horses are required to be back in their stalls at 9:00 p.m., unless requested by a vet to do otherwise.
- 9. Halters must be worn at all times.
- 10. No horses may be ridden between barns and the ring, nor shall any horse be out on the South end of the barns.
- 11. TWO persons from a group MUST be in the barn at all times from 1:00 pm to 10:00 pm, except on Tuesday and Thursday, when time begins at 5:00pm.
- 12. Shoes or boots are required to be worn at all times while in the barn areas. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- 13. CLUB LEADERS: Sign-in sheet is required to be turned in to the Horse Superintendent. Each horse barn participant is to lean walkways, help people, answer questions, and direct questions or concerns to the Horse Superintendent.
- 14. Pre-entry fee is \$15 per horse, to be paid at time of pre-entry.
- 15. Horse age is computed from January 1 of the current year.
- 16. No premium will be awarded when the animal is not worthy, even with no competition present.
- 17. Exhibitors may show 2 (two) horses, pending stall availability.

- Quilts are to be brought to the Civic Center on the Saturday before Fair from 3:00pm until
 6:00pm, OR Sunday before Fair from 3:00 pm until7:00 pm.
- 11. Quilts are to remain on display in the Civic Center all week during the Fair. Quilts can then be picked up on the Sunday AFTER Fair, from 9:00 am until 1:00 pm. NOTE: If you cannot

pick up your quilts during these hours, you must make arrangements with the Quilt Show Superintendent PRIOR to Sunday.

- 12. Each exhibitor will be given ONE Exhibitor Pass on entry day. Do not lost it, or you will have to pay to enter the grounds each day. NOTE: these passes are for entry into the grounds only, and will not get you into the carnival or the grandstand.
- 13. Awards will not necessarily be in cash, based on sponsor preference, but will have AT LEAST the value stated.

- 1 ENTRY DEADLINE IS THE LAST SUNDAY IN JULY. Entries can be mailed, using the official Northern District Fair Entry Form from this Fairbook. Entries can also be made online at: NorthernDistrictFair.FairEntry.com.
- 2 The Youth Department is open to all youth members in the State of Michigan, who are members of a 4H club, FFA club, or other livestock/youth organization. Leader/Advisor names must be furnished on request.

3 YOUTH MEMBER AGE IS 5 YEARS TO 18 YEARS, AS OF JANUARY 1 OF CURRENT FAIR YEAR.

- 4 NOTE: Youth members must be 9 years of age (as of January 1) to exhibit in any cattle class.
- 5 Stall and cage reservation forms must be filled out and sent to the Northern District Fair Livestock Department, with appropriate funds, by the last Sunday in July. Reservation forms are in this Fairbook.
- 6 Exhibitors are to keep their areas clean at all times during the entire Fair week. Sawdust is furnished and available all week. Pens and cages are REQUIRED to be completely and thoroughly cleaned TWICE PER DAY, before 10:00 am and again before 6:00 p.m. On show days, pens must be cleaned PRIOR to the start of the show. Each barn superintendent will check pen cleanliness throughout the day. Those members not cleaning their areas will be given two warnings only. After the second warning, if cleanliness has not improved, a minimum of 10% will be . deducted from market checks.

- 7 Anyone participating in a Fair-sponsored activity, who is caught in the act of theft or vandalism, or who is caught with illegal drugs or alcohol, shall have their parents summoned immediately, and appropriate action will be taken.
- 8 No more than one entry will be accepted from any one exhibitor in any one class, unless specific class rules state otherwise.
- 9 All exhibits shall remain in place until 7:00 am Sunday morning after Fair, at which time they will be picked up by processors, or surrendered by Superintendents. Premium monies are paid AFTER barns are completely cleaned. Market proceeds are available in September, once all buyers have paid for their purchases. Exact date will be announced.

SHOWMANSHIP SWEEPSTAKES RULES

SENIOR: This class is for 15-18 year olds that win a first place in a showmanship class. This person can only compete from ONE SPECIES. An exhibitor can only win Senior Showmanship Sweepstakes ONCE. INTERMEDIATE: This class is for 10-14 year olds that win a first place in a showmanship class. An exhibitor can only win Intermediate Showmanship Sweepstakes ONE TIME. They may move up to Senior Sweepstakes class in subsequent years. If an Intermediate wins the Senior Sweepstakes, they are no longer eligible to show in Sweepstakes classes in future years.

**If the first-place showman is already competing in one species, the second-place exhibitor will be allowed to compete.
