

YOUTH PROJECT RULES

****COMPLETE MARKET LIVESTOCK RULES CAN BE FOUND ON OUR WEBSITE, OR FROM THE 4H OFFICE. Please read them!! northerndistrictfair.org**

- 1 ENTRY DEADLINE IS THE LAST SUNDAY IN JULY. Entries can be mailed, using the official Northern District Fair Entry Form from this Fairbook. Entries can also be made online at: NorthernDistrictFair.FairEntry.com.
- 2 The Youth Department is open to all youth members in the State of Michigan, who are members of a 4H club, FFA club, or other livestock/youth organization. Leader/Advisor names must be furnished on request.
- 3 **YOUTH MEMBER AGE IS 5 YEARS TO 18 YEARS, AS OF JANUARY 1 OF CURRENT FAIR YEAR.**
- 4 NOTE: Youth members must be 9 years of age (as of January 1) to exhibit in any cattle class.
- 5 Stall and cage reservation forms must be filled out and sent to the Northern District Fair Livestock Department, with appropriate funds, by the last Sunday in July. Reservation forms are in this Fairbook.
- 6 Exhibitors are to keep their areas clean at all times during the entire Fair week. Sawdust is furnished and available all week. Pens and cages are REQUIRED to be completely and thoroughly cleaned TWICE PER DAY, before 10:00 am and again before 6:00 p.m. On show days, pens must be cleaned PRIOR to the start of the show. Each barn superintendent will check pen cleanliness throughout the day. Those members not cleaning their areas will be given two warnings only. After the second warning, if cleanliness has not improved, a minimum of 10% will be deducted from market checks.
ALL animal exhibitors are required to sign a Cleanliness Policy agreement on Sunday/Entry day.
- 7 Anyone participating in a Fair-sponsored activity, who is caught in the act of theft or vandalism, or who is caught with illegal drugs or alcohol, shall have their parents summoned immediately, and appropriate action will be taken.
- 8 No more than one entry will be accepted from any one exhibitor in any one class, unless specific class rules state otherwise.
- 9 All exhibits shall remain in place until 7:00 am Sunday morning after Fair, at which time they will be picked up by processors, or surrendered by Superintendents. Premium monies are paid AFTER barns are completely cleaned. Market proceeds are available in September, once all buyers have paid for their purchases. Exact date will be announced.
- 10 Trophies and ribbons will be presented as they are won. Other awards earned throughout the week will be presented at the awards banquet on Saturday afternoon.
- 11 Exhibitors are to provide their own feed and hay.
- 12 SHOWMANSHIP classifications for small animals and livestock shall be:
Beginner showmanship -- age 5
Junior showmanship -- age 6-9
Intermediate showmanship -- age 10-14
Senior showmanship -- age 15 - 18
- 13 All small animals and livestock must be the bonafide property of the exhibitor at the time of entry.
- 14 ALL ANIMALS MUST BE IN PLACE BY 6:00PM ON THE FIRST SUNDAY OF FAIR!
ALL EXHIBITORS MUST ATTEND THE MANDATORY MEETING AFTER WEIGH-IN ON SUNDAY!

15 **NEW FOR 2023:**

BEGINNER SHOWMAN (for 5-yr-old exhibitors who are showing for their very first year)

***Beginner exhibitors may show all species EXCEPT BEEF.**

***Beginner exhibitors must enter Beginner Showmanship.**

***An adult MUST be present in the ring with the Beginner exhibitor to assist and for safety of the youth.**

16 **NEW FOR 2023:**

Record Books are to be turned in at the Small Animal Barn no later than NOON on MONDAY of Fair.

You will be given a Project Summary page when you turn in your Record Books. This Summary of your market project must be filled out and returned by NOON on THURSDAY of Fair. Failure to turn in your Project Summary Page will result in a penalty of 10% being deducted from your Market Checks.

SHOWMANSHIP SWEEPSTAKES RULES

SENIOR: This class is for 15-18 year olds that win a first place in a showmanship class. This person can only compete from ONE SPECIES. An exhibitor can only win Senior Showmanship Sweepstakes ONCE.

INTERMEDIATE: This class is for 10-14 year olds that win a first place in a showmanship class. An exhibitor can only win Intermediate Showmanship Sweepstakes ONE TIME. They may move up to Senior Sweepstakes class in subsequent years. If an Intermediate wins the Senior Sweepstakes, they are no longer eligible to show in Sweepstakes classes in future years.

****If the first-place showman is already competing in one species, the second-place exhibitor will be allowed to compete.**

****Species shows for both levels are: Horse, Swine, Beef, Chicken, Goat Lamb, Turkey, Rabbit.**

****NOTE: ALL SPECIES MUST HAVE AN ENTRY IN THE FAIR IN ORDER TO BE ABLE TO HOLD SHOWMANSHIP SWEEPSTAKES.**
