## **Camper Conduct & Grounds Rules**

To ensure a safe, enjoyable, and respectful environment for all, campers must adhere to the following rules. By entering the campground, you agree to comply with these guidelines:

Fires are allowed only in above-ground fire pits. Ground fires are strictly prohibited. Violators will be asked to leave without a refund.

Pit bikes are not allowed to be ridden in the pits or anywhere within the campground area. They must remain parked unless in designated riding areas (if applicable).

Fairground barns and buildings are off-limits, unless clearly marked for an event. Do not enter or tamper with any structures Keep your space clean. Be sure to pack out all trash—no littering or abandoned items.

Vandalism, unsafe behavior, or violation of these rules will result in immediate removal from the grounds without a refund.

Quiet time is 10:00 PM. Please respect quiet hours by keeping noise levels (including music and generators) to a minimum.

DEQ Requirement: A minimum of 4 feet of space must be maintained between camper units.

Dogs: Dogs are allowed at campers only. They must remain on a leash at all times.

Sewer Hook-Ups: There are NO sewer hook-ups available on the grounds.

Check-in: Please check in at the "Block House" located straight in on the grounds upon arrival for camping registration.

Dump Station: A dump station is available at the south end of the grounds for waste disposal.

Water: There is no water hook-up, but potable water is available for use.
