

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER**  
**Exceeded Maximum Contaminant Level (MCL) for Haloacetic Acids**

**MOUNTAIN TOP PSD, WV3301205**

*Our water system recently violated a drinking water standard. Although this is not an emergency, you, as our customers have the right to know what happened, what you should do, and what we are doing to correct the situation.*

*We routinely monitor for the presence of drinking water contaminants. Test results for 4/1/2026 and 6/30/2026 show that our system exceeds the standard or maximum contaminant level (MCL) for Haloacetic Acids.*

The average level of Haloacetic Acids over the last four quarters was 67.000000000µg/L at GORMANIA GAS AND GO location. The standard for Haloacetic Acids is 60.0µg/L.

**What should I do?**

*You do not need to use an alternative (e.g. bottled) water supply. However, if you have specific health concerns, it is recommended that you consult with your doctor.*

**What does this mean?**

This is not an immediate risk. If it had been, you would have been notified immediately. However, some people who drink water containing Haloacetic acids in excess of the MCL over many years may have an increased risk of getting cancer.

**What happened? What is being done?** (Describe corrective action)

*We feel that extreme drought over the past couple years, along with the inability to flush our mainlines on our regular schedule, has increased the amount of Haloacetic Acids.*

*Currently, we are flushing the system in the effected area more in order to reduce the level. We are working with other agencies to find out why we have increased levels and to learn what remedies are available.*
