

Rays Kids Preschool - Policies & Guidelines

1. Settling-In Period (Initial Days)

- We follow a gradual settling-in approach for new children. On the initial days, your child will attend school for just 1 hour, gradually extending to the full schedule over 1–2 weeks, depending on individual comfort levels.
- Activities such as art, music, and fun activities will be introduced to help your child adjust smoothly.
- ✓ Your cooperation in building a reassuring and positive routine is essential.
- X Please avoid lingering near the premises after drop-off. Children may feel unsettled if they know you're around.
- X A cheerful goodbye with a confident "see you soon" helps more than repeated or emotional farewells.

2. Drop-off & Pick-up Procedures

- Always hand over your child directly to the staff and reassure them at drop-off.
- ✓ At pick-up, warmly greet your child—they look forward to seeing you!
- X Avoid talking on the phone or walking away while dropping off.
- × Please refrain from prolonged goodbyes or loud conversations outside the school gate. Our staff will help children with footwear and safely hand them over.

3. Food & Nutrition

- Pack nutritious snacks or lunch such as chapatis, fruits, idli, dosa, sandwiches, or upma. Please cut food into small pieces for easy handling.
- Provide a labelled water bottle for your child.
- X Junk food such as chips, fizzy drinks, Maggi, etc. is strictly not allowed.
- X Food sharing is discouraged due to allergies and individual dietary needs.

4. Dress Code

- We prefer to send your child in school uniform; however it is not mandatory.
- If not uniform, then dress your child in loose, comfortable clothing.
- ✓ Use easy-to-manage footwear for your child no need for shoes or socks.
- Provide two sets of spare clothes (labelled) to be kept at school.
- Ensure all belongings (bags, bottles, etc.) are clearly labelled with your child's name.
- X Avoid complicated clothing or shoes your child can't manage independently. Self-help skills build confidence.

5. Health & Illness

- Inform the school in case of illness or long absence.
- First aid will be provided as needed, and medical help sought in emergencies.
- X Do not send your child to school if they are unwell, have a fever, cough, cold, diarrhoea, or any contagious illness.

6. Toilet Training

- We support toilet training at school, but parents are expected to take primary responsibility.
- Communicate your child's needs to help us support them better.
- Prefer to avoid diapers unless absolutely necessary. Diapers are only used for children who are not toilet trained, primarily for hygiene reasons. However, we aim to support toilet training as early as possible.

7. Birthdays, Festivals & Celebrations

- Birthdays may be celebrated with prior notice. We recommend eco-friendly return gifts like stationery, books, or plant saplings.
- We celebrate various festivals inclusively and respectfully as part of cultural learning.
- X Avoid elaborate or lavish celebrations that could set unequal expectations among children.

8. Visitors & Observations

- ✓ Parents are encouraged to visit and observe their child's learning process 2–3 times a year.
- Respect the class environment by following visitor guidelines.
- ➤ Please refrain from frequently calling about classroom observations. Be assured your child is under caring and professional supervision.

9. School Property & Materials

- If school material is brought home accidentally, please return it the next day.
- Children are naturally curious and may pick up materials unintentionally.
- \times Personal toys or materials from home should not be brought to school.

10. Emergencies or Accidents

- ✓ In case of injury, our staff will administer first aid immediately and, if needed, consult a nearby doctor. Parents will be informed.
- In case of emergencies (e.g., health issues, citywide strikes), parents will be informed via phone or SMS. If unreachable, emergency contact details from the admission form will be used.

11. Discipline

- Discipline is an essential part of our curriculum. Both the school and parents must model consistent, respectful behaviour.
- Children learn best when they see unity between home and school values.

12. Holidays

- We operate Monday to Friday. School holidays will be available in the Parent App. Kindly plan vacations accordingly.
- If your child is absent, please inform the school. For sudden closures (e.g., bandhs), confirm with the school.
- ✓ In case of any unforeseen event or maintenance, parents will be informed via official communication channels.

13. Communication with Parents

- Teachers communicate through the school diary. Use it for queries or updates.
- School management will share updates via WhatsApp & Email. Calls will be made in urgent or medical cases.
- Parent-Teacher Meetings will be scheduled periodically.

14. Home Environment Support

- Foster independence by allowing children to do simple tasks (pouring water, wearing shoes).
- ✓ Involve them in daily chores—they love helping!
- Model the behaviour you want them to follow.
- Maintain consistent routines for meals, sleep, and playtime.
- Minimize exposure to digital devices; screen time can delay healthy development.
- Refrain from teaching "A for Apple" formats; we follow phonics-based literacy.
