- 4. Minutes were reviewed from the August 17, 2021 Meeting; Motion to accept minutes made by Craig C.; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Jim C.; Motion passed 3-0.
- 5. Bank statement dated August 31, 2021 was reviewed by the Board. Motion to accept ending bank balance of \$732,624.86 made by Jack P.; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Jim C.; Motion passed 3-0. September expenditures were reviewed (copy attached). Motion made by Jack P. to accept expenditures; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Jim C.; Motion passed 3-0. Money Market account balance as of August 31, 2021, was \$750,044.55.

- 7. BDVFD Chief's report presented by Travis S. 59 calls for August, 2021; estimating around 420 calls by the end of December.
- 8. Travis S. has not had any luck getting measurements or finding someone to make a hovercraft trailer; would like to stick with \$11,000.00 deal.

  - Logan Mangold presented the supplemental insurance (critical illness/cancer policies) available for Firefighters and the ESD Board through SFFMA. No cost to participants (covered through the BDVFD budget. Need paperwork completed by Friday.
  - Brock Hometown Christmas is in need of a LARGE tree; asked ESD to sponsor it this year; Former member Josh Kotarski can bring a 48 foot tree from Wisconsin for \$3,200 \$3,500. Motion was made to sponsor the tree in an amount not to exceed \$3,500 by Jim C.; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Jack P.; Motion passed 3-0.
