



- envelope




Here's how to make it:

FROM THE PASTOR...

August 2025

"For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ... If one member suffers, all suffer together with it; if one member is honored, all rejoice together with it."

1 Corinthians 12:12, 26

This 'one body' mentality has unfortunately become foreign to us as American



Christians living in the 22nd century. Unlike other cultures or groups from the past (Native American tribes and our own pioneer ancestors come to mind), we pride ourselves on our self-sustaining and independent attitude. We live in a community, but we usually don't

depend on that community for any meaningful help or cooperation.

The church, however, is different. Or at least it should be. Despite our attempts to be independent and do things for ourselves in other areas of our lives, we see our congregation as a family whose members support each other, help each other out, and depend on one another when times are tough.

As I sit here preparing this article, I can't help but think about the Six Mile Grove member who is nearing the end of his life. By the time you read this, Jerry Sampson may not be with us anymore, and his loss will be felt by many throughout our community. Our sympathies and prayers will certainly go out to Diane and the Sampson family. But as with any member's death, this is an opportunity for the church to shine! We will ALL feel the pain of Jerry's death, we will ALL grieve the loss of a fellow member of Christ's body, and we will ALL pray for the Sampson family as we support them in whatever way we can. This is all part of the healing that needs to take place.

"If one member suffers, all suffer together," Paul says in 1 Corinthians. We will ALL suffer the loss of Jerry Sampson, but not just because he was such an important part of his family, his church, or the Lyle community. We suffer because a part of our own body has been severed.

As we have done so many times in the past, we grieve the loss of a fellow member. But ultimately, we will also rejoice with Diane and her family because of the gift of eternal life Jerry has been given through the cross of Jesus Christ. May the promise of that great gift, and our memories of what a special person Jerry was, be in our hearts these coming days!
