WHO IS BBBS OF ISLAND COUNTY?

Founded in 1999, we offer the best-known, most effective, oldest youth mentoring programs in the world, while remaining one of the smallest and last local, independent chapters affiliated with BBBS of America. We are a true grassroots organization, with six staff on Whidbey Island and more than 250 loyal volunteers who work in every phase of agency activity. All BBBSIC mentoring services are provided entirely free of charge - to over 300 youth in 2023 - with training and support from professional staff.

Our most important goal is to provide safe, caring mentors for youth, defending their unique potential through meaningful relationships and lifelong learning opportunities. Most of the children we work with live in low-income and/or single-parent homes. Mentoring services are grounded in the shared interests of the "Bigs" (adult & high school mentors) and "Littles" (child mentees). The match process is rigorous, involving strict safety measures, parental engagement and thorough, consistent oversight by agency staff. In 2022, we began a new group mentoring program, DINO (Dabble In New Opportunities), that provides new experiences and mentors to youth. This year, we will continue to foster community connections and increase the number of Island County children we serve.





WHY SPONSOR A BBBSIC EVENT?

We served over 300 youth last year in our community by inspiring, empowering, and igniting potential and we couldn't do it without YOU. The number of youth who struggle to reach their full potential has increased in the last few tumultuous years. 25 years serving our local community, over 100 years of national BBBS experience, and research tell us that spending time with a child through mentoring is an effective solution! It is a solution that transforms lives in our community and invests in the future of our world. It leads to improved grades in school, decreases in risky and delinquent behaviors, and increases in self-confidence.

All proceeds go to support BBBS of Island County's programming, events, and staff, and funds stay here in Island County. MEET PRESTON & BRIAN





Little Preston and Big Brian were matched in 2018 in the Site-Based program. Preston's mom, a single parent, enrolled him to help address behavioral concerns, gain additional support, and a positive role model in Preston's life. Brian enrolled as a member of the "Bigs with Badges" program after hearing positive feedback from his coworkers at OHPD. Big Brian shared that the most rewarding part of his job is seeing people learn from their mistakes and make a better life for themselves, and he hoped that he could be a mentor and a friend while promoting positivity in a Little's life.

Big Brian had been visiting Little Preston at his school every week for 2 years when the COVID-19 pandemic forced their meetings to be paused. Big Brian worked to keep their bond strong by sending postcards to him during the lockdown. In 2021, they transitioned to a Community-Based match which has allowed their friendship to flourish.

Some of Little Preston and Big Brian's favorite activities are playing videogames, going bowling, telling jokes, going to the local library, and hiking when the weather is nice. For many years, Little Preston struggled with being bullied by his peers, but in the past year, with the support of his Big, Little Preston has made a new friend with whom he enjoys playing videogames and having sleeping overs. Preston's mom has shared that since being matched, she's noticed a considerable improvement in Little Preston's grades, maturity, and social understanding. With agency staff, Little Preston has grown into one of the most engaging and responsive Littles in the program. Since being matched, Little Preston has developed valuable social skills, overcome behavioral challenges, and built new friendships with peers from whom he used to feel isolated.
