TEAM CAPTAIN RESPONSIBILITIES

*Thank you for supporting mentoring by being a Team Captain in the 2019 Bowl For Kids' Sake!
Here is how to have fun and make a big difference for kids:*

1. Build your team!

- Recruit four people to complete your 5-member team.
- This year's BFKS is **STAR WARS** themed – so keep that in mind when naming your team and feel free to dress up as your favorite **STAR WARS** character!
- Send in your team roster to the BBBS office. You can drop it off, email it to admin@bbbsislandcounty.org, or fax it to (360) 279-1356. You can also call it in at (360) 279-0644. NOTE: team rosters must be submitted by April 12th for t-shirt orders.
- Build more teams by challenging another department, church, office or rival company.

2. Lead your team!

- Give each bowler a pledge envelope and tell them how to participate. Educate them on what BBBS is about and how they can explain to their donors what the money is going towards. (See the info sheet on BBBS & BFKS.)
- Secure pledge commitments totaling at least \$100 per bowler. The more money you raise - the more raffle tickets received for exciting prizes! Grand prizes are also given to the highest fundraising team and highest fundraising bowler!
- Bowlers can advise donors that they can make a donation to them by cash, check, or via credit card on www.bbbsislandcounty.org. Donations can be made over the phone by calling our office at (360) 279-0644.

3. Motivate your team

- Create enthusiasm! Here are team member benefits:
 - * Satisfaction in helping kids in need.
 - * A good time with friends and others at no cost! Anyone can bowl!
 - * Free bowling, pizza, soda, and lots of TERRIFIC PRIZES!
 - * Awards for the team and individual that raises the most funds!
 - * Award for highest bowling score!
 - * Award for best **STAR WARS** themed costume!
- Think of ideas to do as fundraisers. Past bowling teams have done car washes together, bake sales, donated a percentage of their earnings, or have their employers match their collections. Bowlers have also created fundraising campaigns on social media sites like Facebook. (For social media campaigns, please tag BBBSIC for us to record amount raised! Good ideas are those that are unique to you and your team members. You can do it!

4. Follow up frequently!

- Check on team member's progress weekly (in person or through a phone call).
- Do they need help? (We can provide pointers).

5. Final Reminder!

- Two days before the event, make a final reminder call. Tell your team to bring their pledge sheets.
- Each pledge sheet should have a minimum of \$125 in pledges.

6. Arrive early!

- Get to the bowling site 30 minutes before your time. Oak Bowl is located at 531 SE Midway Blvd.
- Sign in, get your shoes, find your lane...and have a blast!
