Try a new To Do To Go activity each month!

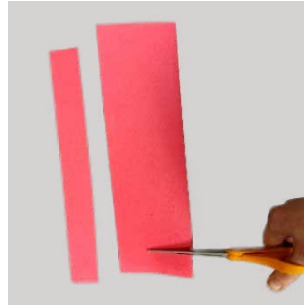
## Paper Lanterns

1



Cut a strip (about 1") from your paper. You'll use this later as the handle for your lantern.

2



Fold your paper in half. Starting from the folded edge, cut a straight line until you get to about 1" away from the end opposite the fold.

3



Repeat with cuts about 1" apart.

4



If you like, decorate with stickers, stamps, washi tape, crayons or pens. Roll paper into a tube and attach with staples, glue, tape or whatever supplies you have on hand.

5



Attach the handle to the top of your lantern.



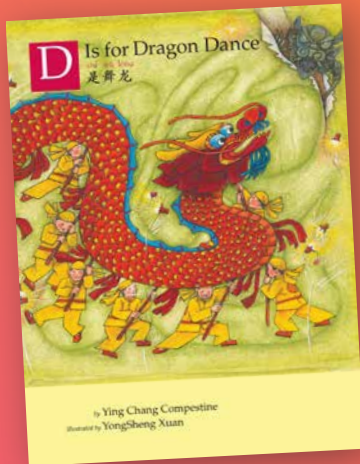
