**NOTICE: PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING LIABILITY STATEMENT:**

The person applying for this burn permit hereby agrees to accept full responsibility for any and all damages or loss that may result from this controlled burning. It is further agreed that the conditions listed within the City of Kempner Burn Ordinance will be met and adhered to by the applicant. The applicant fully agrees that in the event the controlled burning gets out of control (call 911), and the fire department of any city must respond and extinguish the fire(s), the applicant may be required to reimburse the fire department of the city which was called for any and all expenses incurred. The applicant is also liable for damage to adjacent properties.

- Burning will be permitted as long as the burn stays controlled, and the conditions and restrictions listed within the burn application and ordinance are met and maintained during the time of the burn. Should the fire(s) require extinguishing, the permit holder is responsible for that extinguishing
- A Copy of the Permit must be on-site during the time(s) of the burn. The permit must be presented to all authorities asking for it.
- The maximum number of days this permit is valid shall be One Year (365) days. This is given as a courtesy due to bad weather and/or time issues.
- The following departments **must** be notified prior to the start of the burn. It will be the responsibility of the permit holder to make these contacts. Failure to comply may result in the revocation of this permit.

**LAMPASAS SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT: 512-556-8255**

- If at any time a county-wide **BURN BAN** is put into effect, your application and permit are **VOID** for the duration of the **BURN BAN**.
- There **must** be a responsible adult on site with a telephone and adequate water supply during the entire burn and until all fire(s) are extinguished. A check of current weather conditions is also required.
- Do not burn near overhead power, cable, or telephone lines.
- Do not burn near underground power, cable, telephone, sewage, water or gas lines.
- Septic tank must not be located between vehicle access and burn site.
- Burn site cannot be near any trees, buildings, or public roadway.
- Do not burn near stored flammable liquids or gases (propane tank, etc.).
- Do not burn prohibited items (rubber, plastic, milled lumber, household trash or waste, petroleum based products, etc.)
