**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KEMPNER, TEXAS, FOR THE
PEACE OFFICER MENTAL HEALTH GRANT.**

WHEREAS, City Council of the City of Kempner finds it in the best interest of the citizens of The City of Kempner, that the Peace Officer Mental Health grant be operated for the FY 2025- 2026; and

WHEREAS, City Council of the City of Kempner agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the Office of the Governor grant application; and

WHEREAS, City Council of the City of Kempner designates Shaleah Stevens as the grantee's financial officer. The financial officer is given the power to submit financial and/or programmatic reports or alter a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

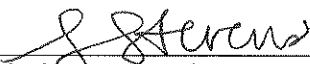

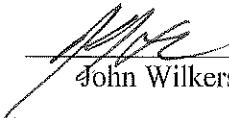
