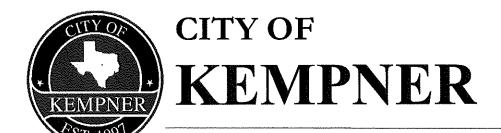

#### MEETING MINUTES

### For the City Council Meeting Held on February 13th 2024

THE CITY COUNCIL CONVENED IN A REGULAR CALLED MEETING IN COUNCIL CHAMBERS, LOCATED AT 12288 E. HWY 190, KEMPNER TX 76539.

### 1. CALL TO ORDER, INVOCATION, AND PLEDGES TO FLAGS

The meeting started at 6:01 PM. The quorum consisted of David Richardson (place 1), Tom Combs (place 2), Rob Green (place 3, Mayor pro tem), Dan Long (place 4), Debbie Hernandez (place 5), and Mayor John "JW" Wilkerson. Gene Isenhour led the invocation.

### 4. ACTION ITEMS

The Council will discuss, and MAY take actions on the following:

A. Discuss and consider the adoption of Ordinance No. 2024-02-13-001, Adopting and Approving Amendments to the Kempner Police Department Policies and Procedure Manual.

Police Chief Heriberto Rodriguez stated these policies are required for the grants we have been awarded and follow the guidelines from the Texas Police Chief's Association of best standards policies. Tom Combs made a recommended change to policy 5.4 Body worn Cameras on page two fixing the alphanumerical numbering from AA to AB.

Rob Green (place 3) made the following motion: To approve Ordinance #2024-02-13-001, with the revisions noted by place 2.

Seconded by: Dan Long (place 4)

All in favor, motion passed unanimously.

B. Receive Bid Proposals and other information and provide directions to the City Manager on the road repair on Hill Street.

Mayor Wilkerson went over the history of Hill Street and the complaints of the poor road conditions. City Manager (CM) Rebecca Ramos explained that she had received three formal bids and a fourth, informal bid from Pct. 1 Commissioner, Bobby Caroll. CM Ramos explained the bids are very different in the approach on repairing the road, but all agree none would be a permanent fix because of the erosion factor. CM Ramos recommended the Council should consider the pairing of one of the bids with the bid from Central Texas Home Lawn Transitions that offers a concrete swale with tinhorns to direct the water from the road. Judge Gene Isenhour stated that before we moved forward with addressing the repair of Hill St., he believed there was a Memorandum Of Understanding (MOU) between the City of Kempner and Lampasas County stipulating the county is responsible for all repairs and maintenance of all city streets beginning or ending with a county road. The council directed CM Ramos to clarify if a MOU was in place and report back to the council.

No other action taken.

C. Consider the approval of the Schedule of Acceptable Fines.

Judge Gene Isenhour explained the standing order and the fines lined out in the order. Mayor Wilkerson stated that an amended ordinance would be presented at the next council meeting. He explained the updated ordinance would contain language giving the judge the ability to set the fee schedules as needed to stay in compliance with updates in legislative session or with a change of judges. Updates in fines would still be presented to the city council.

Rob Green (place 3) made the following motion: to accept the Schedule of Acceptable Fines.

Seconded by: David Richrdson (place 1). All in favor, motion passed unanimously.

D. Consider authorizing use of fund balance to purchase items awarded by grants.

CM Ramos has formally requested authorization from the city council for a fund balance assignment totaling \$126,491.52. Within this allocation, \$11,500 is designated for Park Special Circumstances in alignment with the 2023/2024 adopted budget, while the remaining funds are earmarked for equipment procurement granted to the PD. It was emphasized to the council that compliance with the Conditions of Funding, as stipulated by the grantor, necessitates budget amendments reflecting the awarded amounts. Failure to incorporate these adjustments could render the city ineligible for reimbursement. In essence, the PD initiates equipment purchases, subsequently seeking reimbursement through the established procedure.

The proposed Ordinance, detailed under Section B, encompasses the cumulative value of the five grants at \$122,491.52, excluding the matching funds for the Body Camera grant. To ensure comprehensive coverage, CM Ramos recommended council approval of the full \$126,491.52, encompassing the requisite match for the body cameras.

Mayor Wilkerson provided an update to the council regarding the current status of the fund balance. He elucidated that the presented ordinance aims to facilitate the procurement of necessary equipment by utilizing funds from the balance, followed by the submission of relevant documentation to secure reimbursement from the grant authorities, thereby reinstating the utilized amount back into the fund balance.

Tom Combs (place 2) made the following motion: To authorize the use of fund balance to purchase items awarded by grants.

Seconded by: Rob Green (place 3)

All in favor, Motion passed unanimously.

E. Consider the approval of Ordinance No. 2023-09-26-001 (2024-001), AN ORDINANCE, OF THE CITY OF KEMPNER TEXAS, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024 ANNUAL BUDGET, WHICH WAS PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED BY THE CITY IN ORDINANCE 2023-09-26-001.

Rob Green made the following motion: To approve Ordinance #2023-09-26-001(R2024-001) with amending section 1. B to \$126,491.52.

Seconded by: Tom Combs (place 2)
All In favor, motion passed unanimously.

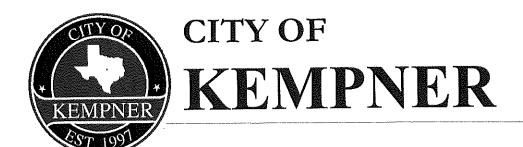

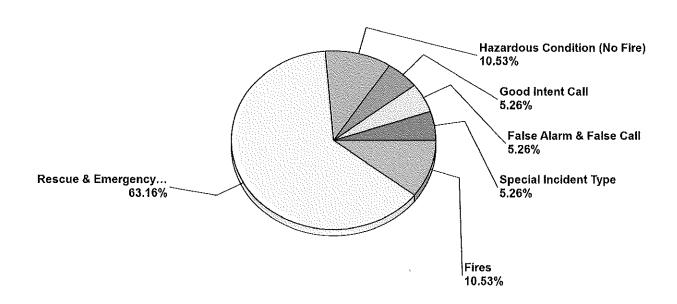
