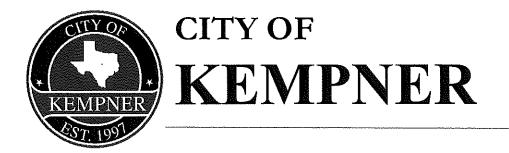

Council Member Green made the following motion: <u>To approve Zac Young as the appraisal</u> <u>company and to let the City Manager choose between Attorney Fees and Professional Fees for the payment.</u>

Mr. Mickan spoke regarding his original offer to the City Manager and Mayor and explained to the council the reasons as to why he only offered the \$15, he also gave the council the reasons why he wants to purchase this land and what he will be doing with it. Mr. Mickan also informed the council that he plans to work with the city on this however he can. Council Member Green told Mr. Mickan that the council decided last week that it was in the city's best interest to get this land appraised mainly to get factual information. Green also said that they understand his needs as well as keeping the city's needs in mind and that this is just for fact finding and not for a negotiation yet. Gene Isenhour explained to Mr. Mickan the history of why the city is moving forward with an appraisal and that there is a process to follow.
