

The council expressed a preference to first explore potential budget cuts before considering a tax increase. Council Member Rob Green emphasized the importance of providing a clear public notice if a tax increase becomes necessary, to ensure public input. The mayor recommended further analysis of the budget and potential cuts, with a plan to revisit the issue at the next council meeting
