Deferred Disposition is a suspend sentence (probation). On your plea of guilty or no contest, the Judge will defer the finding of guilt until a later date, assess the applicable fees and order you to comply with certain conditions. If you successfully comply with the terms, your case will be dismissed.

However, if you fail to comply with the terms and conditions of the Deferred Disposition a guilty judgment may be imposed and a conviction may be reported to the Texas Department of Public Safety.

IMPORTANT: If you are under the age of 25, you will be ordered to take a Driver Safety Course as a condition of Deferred Disposition.

You may apply for Deferred Disposition via mail by submitting the items below within 21 days of the day you received your citation. The Judge will review your application and Deferred Disposition will only be granted at the discretion of the reviewing Judge. You will be notified by mail if your request is granted. **Payment of citation will be due within 90 days of order issued by the Judge.**

The following items must accompany your signed application:

1. A copy of your valid Driver's License (not a Commercial Driver's License (CDL));
2. Current proof of insurance; and
3. 3A driving record from the State your Driver's License was issued. (texas.gov)

There are certain cases which require you to appear in person to request Deferred Disposition. Request by mail **WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED** for the following offenses:

- 25 miles or more over the posted speed limit
- Any offense by a holder of a CDL (Commercial Driver's License)
- Passing a school bus
- Any traffic violation that occurred in a construction zone with workers present
- Non-traffic cases
- Juvenile cases (must appear in person with parent or guardian)

I hereby enter a plea of Guilty No Contest (check one) to the violation of _____

and waive my right to a jury trial. I have not requested discovery from the State under Art. 39.14 of the Texas Code OF Criminal Procedure. I request that the Court place me on Deferred Disposition for this case. I understand that if I successfully complete the terms of Deferred Disposition in by the date of the court order, my case will be dismissed. If I do not successfully complete the terms of the Deferred Disposition, I will receive a notice to appear in court to show cause why I did not complete the terms of the Deferred Deposition as ordered. Furthermore, I understand that if I do not show sufficient cause, the Deferred Disposition will be revoked and a judgment of guilty will be entered and may be reported to the Texas Department of Public Safety in accordance with Texas Code Of Criminal Procedure, Art. 27.14(c).
