ORDINANCE NO. <u>1998-04-07-001</u>

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KEMPNER, TEXAS, PROVIDING THAT THE REGULAR TERMS OF OFFICE FOR MAYOR AND ALDERMEN WILL BE TWO-YEAR STAGGERED TERMS; MAKING FINDINGS OF FACT.

Whereas, Tex. Loc. Govt. Code 23.026, Regular Terms of Office, Subsection (b), authorizes the City Council to provide by ordinance for two-year staggered terms of office for the Mayor and Aldermen.

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kempner, Texas, that:

Section 1. Findings of Fact. All of the above premises and recitations are found to be true and correct and are incorporated into the body of this ordinance as findings of fact, as if copied herein in their entirety.

Section 2. Mayor and Aldermen Two-Year Staggered Terms The office of Mayor and Aldermen within the City of Kempner, Texas, are hereby declared and ordained to be two-year staggered terms established under Tex. Loc.. Govt.. Code 23.026, Regular Terms of Office, Subsection (b).

<u>Section</u> 3. <u>Open Meetings</u>. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this ordinance was passed was open to the public, and public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given, as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code.
