

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KEMPNER, TEXAS, MAKING FINDINGS OF FACT; DETERMINING THE POPULATION OF THE CITY OF KEMPNER; AND PROVIDING FOR RELATED MATTERS.

Whereas, the present population of the City is well in excess of 1,000 persons; and

Whereas, the City Council has the lawful authority to make such inquiry and examination as necessary to determine the population of the City based upon the facts;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KEMPNER, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. Findings. The recitations hereinabove and hereafter in this section are found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein as findings of fact. The City Council hereby further finds and determines that (a) the average population per residential water meter within the City is at least 2.57 persons per residential water meter based upon research and comparative data from the 1990 census; (b) more than 400 residential water meters are within the limits of the City; (c) a number of such 400 plus meters serve multiple residential units and mobile homes; and (d) that the true and correct population of the City is more than 1,000 persons.


Section 2. City Population. Based upon information and evidence presented and available to the City Council, the City Council hereby finds, determines and declares the true and correct population of the City to be 1,027 persons as of 15th day of June, 1999.

Section 3. Open Meetings. That it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this ordinance is passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, *Tex. Gov't. Code, Chapt. 551*.


