ORDINANCE NO. 1999-06-15-003

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KEMPNER, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A CHANGE FROM A TYPE "B" GENERAL LAW MUNICIPALITY TO A TYPE "A" GENERAL LAW MUNICIPALITY; AND PROVIDING SEVERABILITY, OPEN MEETINGS AND EFFECTIVE DATE CLAUSES.

Whereas, the City of Kempner (the "City"), Texas has more than 600 inhabitants within the corporate limits;

Whereas, at least two-thirds of the City Council of the City at a regular meeting voted to change from a type "B" General-Law City to change to a type "A" General-Law Municipality;

Whereas, the City Council, after accepting citizens comments and statements at an open public meeting, determined that the citizens of Kempner would be better served under the Type "A" General-Law designation; and,

Whereas, the City is authorized by the *Tex. Loc. Gov't Code §6.011* to change the designation of the City to a Type "A" General-Law Municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KEMPNER, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. Findings. The foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted by the City Council and made a part hereof for all purposes as findings of fact.
- <u>Section</u> 2. <u>Authorization</u>. Upon the effective date of this Ordinance the City of Kempner shall be and become a Type "A" General-Law Municipality. The Mayor shall sign a copy of the record of these proceedings and the City Secretary shall attest the record of these proceedings under corporate seal and a copy of the record shall be filed and recorded in the office of the county clerk of the county of Lampasas, Texas.
- <u>Section</u> 3. <u>Continuation</u>. The City shall retain the name the City of Kempner, Texas and continue to be a body corporate with perpetual succession.
- <u>Section</u> 4. <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this ordinance or the application of any provision to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not effect other provisions or applications hereof which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.
- Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and filing in the manner set forth with the provisions of the Tex. Loc. Gov't Code §6.012.

<u>Section 6.</u> <u>Open Meetings</u>. That it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this ordinance is passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the *Open Meetings Act*, *Chapt. 551, Tex. Gov't. Code*.
