

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-03-03-004

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KEMPNER, TEXAS,
AUTHORIZING THE USE OF RESTRICTED STREET FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO
EXCEED \$48,000.00 FOR ELIGIBLE STREET MAINTENANCE AND/OR IMPROVEMENT
EXPENDITURES FOR PECAN STREET AND PEDERNALES STREET; AND PROVIDING FOR
AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS the City of Kempner, Texas (the "City"), maintains restricted Street Funds designated solely for lawful street maintenance and improvement purposes; and

WHEREAS the City Council has identified necessary maintenance and/or improvement work on Pecan Street and Pedernales Street within the City limits; and

WHEREAS the proposed work qualifies as eligible expenditures under applicable laws governing the use of restricted Street Funds; and

WHEREAS on March 10, 2026, the City Council considered the authorization of restricted Street Funds for the maintenance and/or improvement of Pecan Street and Pedernales Street; and

WHEREAS the City Council finds that authorizing the use of restricted Street Funds in an amount not to exceed Forty-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$48,000.00) for these projects is in the best interest of the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Kempner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KEMPNER, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. FUNDS AUTHORIZED: The City Council hereby authorizes the use of restricted Street Funds in an amount not to exceed Forty-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$48,000.00) for eligible street maintenance and/or improvement expenditures for Pecan Street and Pedernales Street.

Section 2. POWERS GRANTED: The City Manager is hereby authorized to take all necessary actions to implement this Resolution, including execution of any necessary agreements and documents, consistent with applicable procurement requirements and within the authorized funding limit.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

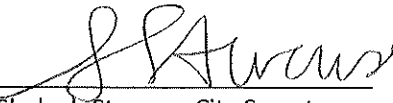
