What do you do when students have not yet reached mastery?			
50% or More of class not at mastery Whole Class Reteach of needed skill with explicit Modeling and opportunity for student practice with feedback. Set goals with students for learning targets. Break Learning targets into smaller chunks and reteach with alternative examples.	30-49% of class not at mastery Spiral review through bellwork or exit tickets. Think-pair-share discussions over identified misconceptions. Whole class test corrections on most missed items with why they chose incorrect answers and expand on correct one.	O-29% of class not at mastery Small group instruction with target interventions Targeted differentiated work on technology platforms or homework with expanded explanation. Peer to Peer Tutoring with specific and designed pairings.
