27th Annual Young Astronaut Day -An Out of This World Success

180 students and 60 teachers/parents were in attendance at the 27th Annual Young Astronaut Day (YAD) outreach event held at the Cleveland State University Wolstein Center on November 9th, 2019. First through eighth grade students competed in various hands-on STEM challenges meant to simulate the various tasks that NASA engineers work on to help get humans into space. Astronaut Doug "Wheels" Wheelock gave an inspirational keynote address explaining that "ordinary" kids can grow up to do extraordinary things, such as becoming an astronaut and making it into Space. The student activities this year included (and were led by): Lightweight Aerospace Materials (Mary Jo Long-davis), Planetary Lander (Sydney Schnulo), Remote Sensing (David Friedlander), Spacecraft Safety (Jerry Voltz), Robotic Arm (Herb Schilling), and Spudnaut (Dan Londrico). YAD was made possible through the efforts of 50 volunteers, including many regional engineers, the Cleveland State University AIAA student chapter, and several AIAA members. This year's event was organized by the Northern Ohio Section of AIAA and supported by the Cleveland State University Washkewicz College of Engineering. 
