A special Thank You to all of these award winners from me for your continuing work to make the Club the success that it is.

& Woman of the Year, Junior, Social, and Dirty Bird of the Year will be announced. The Board also approved holding a drawing for the 88 members who earned 10%-er status last year (through April 30, 2020). There will be two firearms in the drawing – a Smith & Wesson 60-15 Revolver in .357 magnum, and a Chaippa Lever Action .22 LR with a soft case. Two names will be drawn at random from the list of 10%-ers. First name drawn will have their choice of firearm. The Board approved purchase of Pelican Vault 200 cases for all 10%-ers. They will be available for distribution as soon as they arrive.

The Board also approved holding a donation auction for the remaining firearms the Club received through donations and Friends of NRA Dinners. These include a new Kimber Custom II pistol in .45 ACP, a new Mossberg 535G 12 ga pump shotgun with two camo barrels, an older Stevens 12 ga pump shotgun, and a new FMK Lower Receiver plus an AR style carrying case. Each member may submit one bid for each firearm in which they have an interest. If there are competing bids for the same firearm, the highest bid will be the winner. In case of a tie, only those bidders will have an opportunity to raise their bid. The Board reserves the right to reject bids that are deemed to be too low. Bidding will begin on August 4 to allow for all members to have the opportunity to bid, and may be submitted to Jerry Shiller by email, snail mail, or in person. The firearms will be available for inspection at the August 4th Membership meeting. Bidding will close on August 18, and the Board will notify the successful bidders within a day or two after. Successful bidders will be able to choose where they want to DROS their firearms.

The Board approved purchasing new AR-500 steel targets for the rifle range. When they get here, there will be a restriction placed on their use with high velocity ammo as the target manufacturer has data to show rounds traveling over 2900 f.p.s. damage even their hardest steel. The Board also approved 14 new members into the Club; including some who didn't have any grey hair. Many had been waiting since February due to COVID restrictions.
