Summary October 18, 2022 Board of Directors Meeting

The Board approved 5 new members. To all members, keep up the pace of bringing new members to the Club. It will help us stay strong. The Board started discussing how to consolidate the Members Meeting and the Board Meeting into one night. Tentatively (and still subject to change), the Board decided to initially try the 3rd Tuesday for the combined meeting. We would start at 6:30 pm; the first up to 1.5 hours would be for the Members Meeting where we have reports from all the Club's Shootmasters and reports from standing committees. After the Members Meeting, we will transition to the monthly Board of Directors Meeting for a maximum of 2 hours. Receiving money collected by Shootmasters, as well as reimbursing Club members for their outlays on behalf of the Club received considerable discussion. Treasurer Debby Ludwig will contact our bank to see how we can automate these important functions. The Board was mostly in favor of not changing the requirement for a Prospective member to attend both a member's meeting and a Board meeting, i.e., both requirements will not be able to be satisfied on one night. The Board decided it would work toward having a trial, new meeting schedule in place no later than May 1, the beginning of the next fiscal year. The Board heard that there is a desire to start hunter safety education classes at the Club. A plan to make this happen will be in place soon.

Board member Paul Dugas suggested collecting historic information about Lemon Grove Rod & Gun Club into a small book that will be given to all new members when they join the Club. If you are interested in helping with this project, or contributing historic facts and stories, please contact Paul.

The Board approved a plan to expand the Family Fun Shoot to include more shooting in addition to trap and sporting clays. Tentatively, the first new format event will be held Sunday morning, February 9, 2023. In addition to trap shooting, the rifle and pistol ranges will be open for members only to shoot. We are looking at ways to offer samples of some of the Club's matches at this event so that members who don't ordinarily come to the events might have the opportunity to try something different. Membership Chair Tom Bledsoe is the contact point if you want to help as an RSO or plan some food for all to eat following shooting. We decided to call the new format "Family on Target." Specific details will be forthcoming.

Environmental Training Corner

Hazardous materials storage at Lemon Grove Rod & Gun Club is restricted to items used by the range for necessary range activities. These items must be stored in the locations and quantity as specified below

Fuels are to be stored only in the gas shed behind the upper trap field, and no more than 55 gallons at a time in appropriately labeled containers

No more than five 1-gallon containers of chlorine based bactericide may be stored in the well house

No hazardous materials storage is allowed in conex boxes 1,2 or 3, nor any in the semi-trailer

Hazardous materials are allowed in limited quantities in conex boxes 4 and 5

UPCOMING TRAINING AT LEMON GROVE ROD AND GUN CLUB

Shooters,

- While I have been out of the picture Stan has been plugging away with his amazing Defensive Handgun classes on Friday nights, if you haven't been to one yet what are you waiting for?
- We also had another Stop the Bleed class, this time taught by the Head RN at Sharp Memorial Trauma Department. We are setting this up as a recurring class so everyone can attend.
- October will have a Stop the Bleed class and we will be starting the 3 class pipelines required for each instructor certification: Basic Rifle, Basic Pistol and Basic Shotgun. We are also going to squeeze in a Image Based Decisional Drills class and an OC Spray (Pepper Spray) class.
- These classes are set up for you to get the training you want / deserve, take advantage when you can. Let us know if there is any other training you would like to have at the range. The Phil Kliner seminar is a direct result of your inputs.

Defensive Handgun 2nd and 4th Friday every month from 5-9

Biomechanics of movement and the neuroscience of the decisional process and training methodologies will be explored. If you shoot competitively or carry a pistol for personal protection you will benefit from this class.
