Summary July 18, 2023 Board of Directors Meeting

The Board approved six new members. Be sure to get to know them when you see them on the range. The Board approved renewing the Wild Apricot database management subscription (\$2,592) and the Umbrella Liability Insurance policy (\$1,673) for the coming year. The Board approved supporting San Diego County Gun Owners Second Amendment celebration (aka Gun Prom) by purchasing a table of 10 seats for the September 16, 2023, event (see separate article below). The Board agreed in principle to look for a new bank to handle the Club's business. First Republic Bank, our current banker, still exists. But JP Morgan Chase Bank, which purchased First Republic a couple months ago, has a reputation for not being particularly gun friendly. We will also be putting some money in an interest-bearing account to earn a little more money for the Club. After much discussion, the gate fee for pistol matches was increased from \$15 to \$20 at the request of Shootmaster/Director Paul Lichtenstein. Sign ups for the monthly sporting clays activity will be modified, possibly for the August 27 shoot, to favor members having first choice for starting times. Several other discussions were tabled until all Board members can be present.

Environmental Training Corner

The Range Chair shall be notified of any storage of hazardous materials at the range required for facilities and maintenance work. Once the work has been completed, surplus maintenance materials or potentially hazardous materials that were brought onto Club property for the maintenance activity by members, guests or contractors shall be removed by them from Club property. Any maintenance of personal vehicles that generates hazardous waste, or storage of hazardous materials by individuals or members is prohibited on Club property. Lemon Grove Rod & Gun Club has identified containers for paper and plastic waste for recycling. Members and guests are asked to place their cardboard, plastic, and paper into the appropriate container/bin.

This class will help prepare you to use O.C. Spray as part of your personal defensive strategy. While a gun is the ultimate equalizer stopping a determined attacker, most situations don't require that level of force. O.C. spray gives you a tool that fills that gap between a harsh word and a gun that can deter the attacker without the legal ramifications of using a gun. It can also be carried by anyone, even in most places firearms are not allowed.

This is a class that will benefit EVERYONE, whether you choose to carry a gun or not.

We will be using INERT spray on each other in the class, THERE WILL BE NO LIVE EXPOSURE, so you will not feel the pain.

Cost: \$50 for members, \$75 for non-members and does include one inert and one live POM O.C. Spray canister.


