 the candidates. If this requirement IS NOT fulfilled, those officials are INELIGIBLE to
 work sectional play off games the following year—those officials would be assessed a
 fine equivalent to the current varsity game fee. (Members will vote on this proposed
 change)
- Failure to pay dues &/or fines by May 31st will incur an additional fine of \$35

Miscellaneous:

- ALL active Board 52 members MUST pay the annual dues if you are officiating basketball at ANY LEVEL.
- Failure to comply with the above will result in you being removed from the Board 52 roster. BOCES and all local assignors will be notified that you are NOT a "member in good standing."
- If your dues &/or fines are not paid, you CANNOT attend the annual dinner.

NYS 5-Point Program

Approved Officials are Officials who:

- 1. Observe the constitution and bylaws of their local and state officials organization.
- 2. Attend the mandatory interpretation meeting and mandatory business meeting*, and at least 3 other regular meetings of the local organization each year.
- 3. Give satisfactory evidence of proficiency in the mechanics of officiating and of competent performance related to the specific sport.
- 4. Pass the National Federation, State, or other approved rules examination (Method of testing may vary).
- 5. Be listed on the annual roster submitted by IAABO Board 52, with the New York State Public High School Athletic Association, Inc., Executive Director.

^{*}Members will vote to amend the constitution to change the mandatory business to be optional.
