# **NYS 5-Point Program**

### Approved Officials are Officials who:

- 1. Observe the constitution and bylaws of their local and state officials organization.
- 2. Attend the mandatory interpretation meeting and mandatory business meeting, and at least 3 other regular meetings of the local organization each year.
- 3. Give satisfactory evidence of proficiency in the mechanics of officiating and of competent performance related to the specific sport.
- 4. Pass the National Federation, State, or other approved rules examination (Method of testing may vary).
- 5. Be listed on the annual roster submitted by IAABO Board 52, with the New York State Public High School Athletic Association, Inc., Executive Director.
