



3-Person Certification Program

Each year, Board 52 will have a 3-Person Certification Program, which will provide classroom and on floor training to ALL varsity officials. (Dates and time will be announced.)

The classes and on-court instruction will be provided by members of the Training/Education Committee.

To be eligible to officiate 3-person games during the regular season and postseason/sectional games, officials MUST obtain certification by the Board 52 Training/Education Committee.

Ways to obtain 3-person certification:

- Attend 1 classroom session and 2 on floor sessions per season, offered by Board 52.
 - To be completed by November 30th.
- Attend a 3-person officials' camp during the summer..
 - Camp must be a minimum of 2-days and you must provide proof of attendance.
- Officiate at least FIFTEEN 3-person high school games per season.
 - Proof of schedule required each season.
- Officiate at least TEN 3-person college games per season (Men's or Woman's).
 - Proof of schedule required each season.
- Officiate at least TWELVE 3-person games, which are a combination of college and high school per season.
 - Proof of schedule required each season.

Miscellaneous:

- If you are a retired college official, with at least 20-years of experience, you are exempt from the above mandates.
- Certification must be obtained each season.
- Failure to obtain the 3-person certification will prohibit you from officiating any 3-person games.
