





We all see things differently



• What did you see?


The old lady or the side profile of a young lady?

A vase or two faces?




SHADES OF GRAY

 - In a different game


- How do we balance the grey area calls?







Correct Response: Faking Being Fouled - Embellishing Incidental Contact

- RefQuest YMTC play:
 - 161 selected FBF (Correct Call)
 - o 205 PCF
 - 30 Blocking Foul
 - 14 Incidental Contact

- Some reasons that we see plays differently:
 - Not all plays are simple & definitive
 - Different level of rules knowledge
 - Different level of experience
 - Positioning
 - Correct or Incorrect
 - Right official in the right position to make the right call
 - From where I was positioned, I didn't have a good look at the play
 - Calling out of your PCA
 - This decreases your call accuracy
 - Personal Philosophies
 - Science vs. Art

- Black & White Calls:
 - Out of bounds
 - 5-seconds
 - 10-seconds
 - Automatic Fouls:
 - Arm bar
 - Two hands on dribbler
 - What are some others?

- Grey Area Calls:
 - Traveling
 - Block/Charge/FBF
 - Incidental Contact
 - Illegal Screens
 - Game Interrupters
 - Lopsided game
 - Level of play
 - Previous call



Shades of Grey MAIN PRINCIPLES


- NEVER an excuse for seeing/calling plays differently:
 - POOR POSITIONING
 - POOR RULES KNOWLEDGE
 - PERSONAL PHILOSOPHIES

POOR POSITIONING:

- Move to improve
- Get to the right spot
- Work the arc
- Close down
- A B C from the Lead
- Mirror the ball
- Don't ball watch
- Double the sideline (3-person)
- NEVER be 94 feet apart
- Don't guess
- If you think it is, it isn't

POOR RULES KNOWLEDGE:

- Not knowing the rules is NEVER an excuse for a poor ruling:
 - o For Example:
 - Held ball when the offense retains possession = of the shot clock
 - Double foul = no reset of the shot clock: POI
 - Unless there's no team control



- It may not be acceptable, but it's a fact:
 - Some officials know the rules better than others
- Incorrect rule application can result in the following:
 - Being inconsistent
 - You will have difficulty providing a rules based explanation to coaches &/or players

PERSONAL PHILOSOPHIES:

- NO PLACE IN OUR GAME!
 - "I don't call 3-seconds."
 - "I call the hand checking early."
 - "I have a quick whistle for held balls."
 - "I don't T up coaches."
 - "I don't like to rotate in 3-person."
 - MY FAVORITE: "I'm not a rules guy."
