HERE IS HOW THE REBATE **PROGRAM WORKS:**

- **1.** Call the City's 3-1-1 Customer Service Line and ask to sign up and participate in the City's **Sidewalk Rebate Program**.
- 2. Public Works Department (PWD) staff will receive your request and examine your sidewalk condition. We will then provide you an assessment of required repairs along with an estimate and the amount that will be rebated. You will have 15 business days to accept or reject this estimate.
- **3.** If you accept the estimate, you can then select and hire a licensed contractor of your choice to complete all necessary sidewalk repairs within 60 business days.
- **4.** In order to be eligible for the rebate, when repairs are complete, submit your completed rebate forms and copy of the invoice (or receipt) from the contractor itemizing work and costs.
- **5.** Once repairs have been inspected and approved, you will receive a rebate check by mail for the eligible amount of the repair cost, not to exceed \$3,000. Your check will be mailed to you within 30 business days of the inspection.

NOVEMBER ELECTIONS

Election day is coming!

The general election will be held November 8, 2022.

Early voting will be held from Monday, October 24, 2022 to Friday, November 4, 2022.

Texas law requires eligible voters to register by the 30th day before Election Day. The voter registration deadline for the Nov 8. 2022 Election is Oct 11, 2022.

Please keep in mind that laws for voting by mail have changed. For all info on voting by mail, please contact the Bexar County Elections Department.



This year, Monica started bringing home a crispy and fluffy loaf of bread that was golden brown and covered in sesame seeds. I'd dip the bread in olive oil and ask, "So where did this bread come from again?" Eventually, Monica took me to where she had been ordering lunch (for weeks), and I learned that Chef's Table does more than make bread.

At Chef's Table, you'll find an intimate and beautifully ornamented dining room that serves feasts of flavor. The open kitchen hides no aromas from those who come preapred with adventurous appetites.

Food

Chinese Tallow Trees (aka Popcorn Trees)

<u>Outdoor Seed Dates</u>

- Beats, Oct. 4
- Swiss Chard, Oct. 9
- Turnips, Oct. 9
- Lettuce Oct. 9
- Arugula, Oct. 14
- Radishes, Oct. 14
- Spinach, Oct. 24

Known for their "popcorn white" seed pods and spade-shaped leaves, the tallow was introduced to the US so that southern states could have a soapmaking industry. Now, their oily seeds are a leading source of biodiesel.

Although the tallow is considered invasive, few can deny their impressive, autumnal shades of red, yellow, and orange. Keep an eye out for the neighborhood's tallows this fall. They will be a sight to see!
