UPCOMING IMPROVEMENTS



Crosswalks along Woodlawn and the Young Women's Leadership Academy are slated to receive \$5,845.96 in improvements in the year 2023.

Many of these crosswalks are faded or nonexistent. The improvement will make crossing the street safer by adding visibility to intersections where pedestrians—especially children—frequently cross the street.

Each of the 17 projects for "school zone pavement markings" will cost \$343.88.

CCTV TRAFFIC DETECTION

Traffic at the intersection of Wilson Blvd. and Donaldson Ave. will be monitored with closed circuit television (CCTV).



CCTV street monitoring is designed to help understand the flow of traffic and make intelligence-based solutions for improvements. The estimated cost of the program is \$34,615.38.

The San Antonio River Authority is updating the 100 yr. flood plain maps and has released a draft map which propose to add 50 more homes along or adjacent to Kampmann Blvd and W. Woodlawn into the flood plain.

A public meeting will be held at St. Mary's University, 1 Camino Santa Maria (in University Center - Conference Room B) on Tuesday, March 7, 2023 | 6pm-7:30pm.

The draft maps are proposed to be adopted in mid-2024.


