COMMENTARY: HOW MUCH IS ENOUGH

Have you ever questioned how many staff members work for City Council Members?

Up to the 1950's, city council members gathered to discuss city business, vote and went back to their respective businesses. (This is a simplified view to show there wasn't an abundance of extra council staff members on board).

Until 1955 the city government followed the classic mayor-alderman pattern. In 1955, the Council/Manager form of government was started and allowed the City Manager to carry out the wishes of the council. Fast forward to the 1990's.

To the best of my memory, when District 7 Councilman Bob Ross was installed, one secretary at city hall answered to each council person for city matters.

Councilman Ross had ONE staff member who answered constituent's questions, attended neighborhood meetings, and kept the councilman informed of issues. Sometime between then and now, City Council People have BLOATED the city payrolls with staff persons. Next is the breakdown according to the city's website:

Mayor: 10 Staff members (Ron Nirenberg)

Dist 1: 10 Staff members (Mario Bravo)

Dist 2: 9 Staff members (Jalen McKee-Rodriguez)

Dist 3: 10 Staff members (Phyllis Viagran)

Dist 4: 9 Staff members (Dr. Adriana Rocha Garcia)

Dist 5: 10 Staff members (Teri Castillo)

Dist 6: 8 Staff members (Melissa Cabello Havrda)

Dist 7: 9 Staff members (Rosie Castro)

Dist 8: 9 Staff members (Manny Pelaez)

Dist 9: 10 Staff members (John Courage)

Dist 10: 5 Staff members (Clayton Perry)

Total: 99 Staff members

Each of the staff members draw a salary. The city website doesn't indicate if any of their staff members are volunteers.

If each of them got paid a "living wage", this would total at least \$1,000,000+.

Even though the city's budget is over \$3 billion, what would an extra million pay for? Again, how many is enough?


