Water Conservation Stage 2

This year, our region has experienced extraordinary hot and dry conditions. Inverness Water and Sanitation District's ("Inverness") recognizes that water demands, particularly, irrigation demands, are directly impacted by weather conditions. Inverness water supply is limited. Pursuant to the Resolution and Order of the Board of Directors of Inverness Water and Sanitation District, adopted June 4, 2026, the Board of Directors has ordered Water Conservation Stage 2 mandatory water restrictions on outdoor watering for both potable and non-potable irrigation customers. These restrictions apply to all Inverness customers. The following outdoor water restrictions are in effect from **June 15, 2026 through October 31, 2026** or until lifted by order of the Board of Directors.

INVERNESS WATER CONSERVATION STAGE 2

A) Potable Irrigation Customers

1. No operation of sprinkler irrigation systems is allowed after 9:00 a.m. and before 6:00 p.m. Drip-irrigation and irrigation systems for planter beds are allowed daily.
2. Watering by turf sprinkler systems is allowed two times per week on Customers' desired days of the week.
3. Hand watering is permitted at any time.
4. No washing down paved surfaces except for health and safety purposes.
5. Customers establishing a new turf planted on or after June 15, 2026, please contact Inverness for a New Turf Variance ("NTV").

B) Non-Potable Irrigation Customers

1. No operation of sprinkler irrigation systems is allowed after 9:00 a.m. and before 6:00 p.m. Drip-irrigation and irrigation systems for planter beds are allowed daily.
2. Watering by sprinkler systems is allowed four times per week.
3. Hand watering is permitted at any time.
4. No washing down of paved surfaces without a CDPHE Regulation 84 permit.
5. Customers establishing a new turf planted on or after June 15, 2026, please contact Inverness for a New Turf Variance ("NTV").
