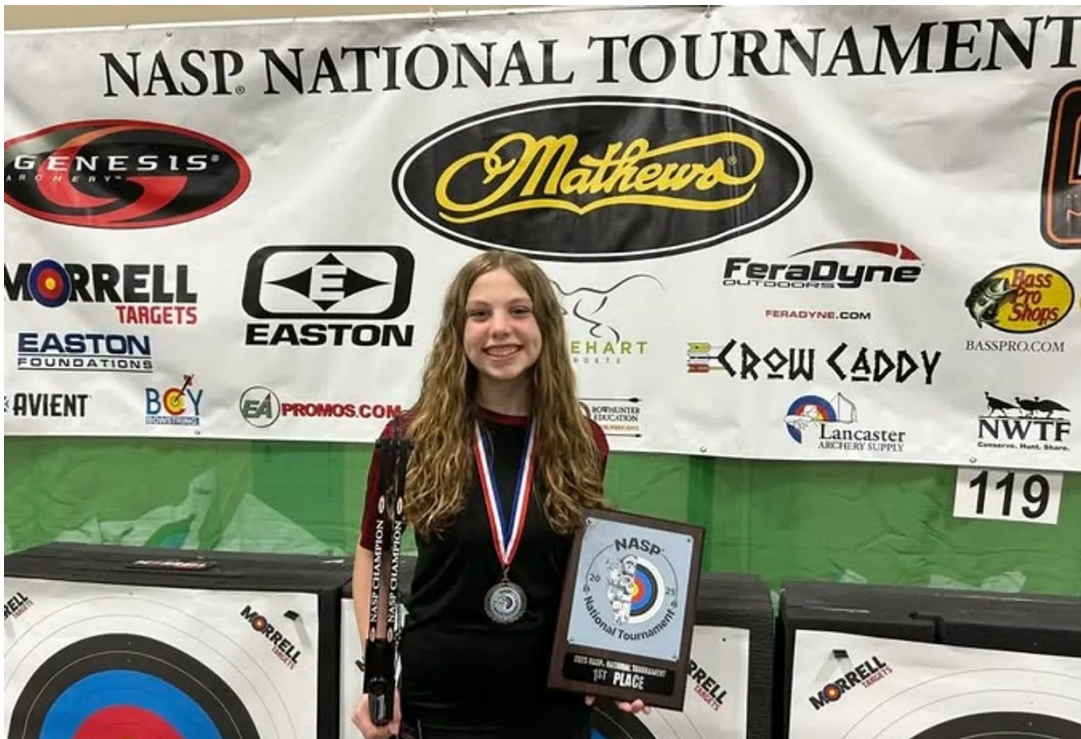

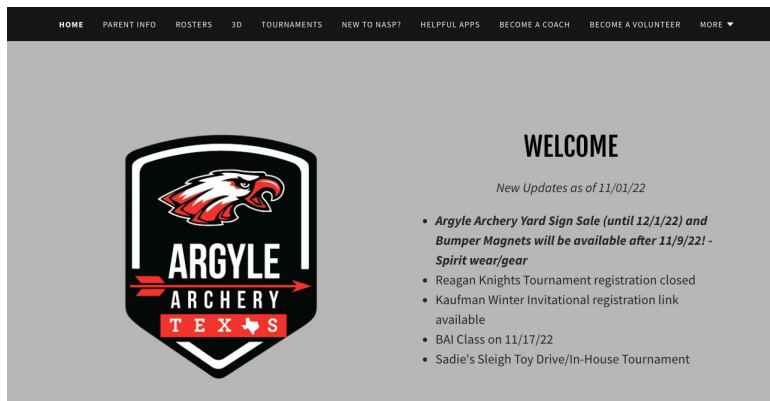

We will use **SignUpGenius** to reserve. Chronic no-shows will be removed from future sign ups.



3D PRACTICE SCHEDULE

HS Coach – Chris Kasallis/MS Coach – TBD

- 3D is only open to Middle and High School archers.
- Must demonstrate above average ability to be invited.
- \$70 payment via TeamSnap once invited.
- Begins in October. Tryouts Oct 23rd.
- Practice: Thurs (MS 7:00pm; HS 8:00pm)
- Occasional extra time on Saturdays
- More information available from coaches after first few weeks of season.



PRACTICE EXPECTATIONS

SAFETY is priority #1

- BE ON TIME (arrive early) and ready when practice time begins
 - Doors cannot be propped open per ISD
 - Late arrival is disruptive to practice
- Behavior & Safety Violations (subject to severity)
 - 1st - sit out a round
 - 2nd - sit out a practice
 - 3rd - sit out a tournament
 - Continued - suspension or dismissal from program



TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE

Local Tournaments - schedule to be posted on

Team Managers are responsible for individual flight times

Minimum Tournament Requirement:

- HS – 5 tournaments + State
- MS – 4 tournaments + State
- Elementary – 3 tournaments + State



TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE

Tournament Fees

Tournament fees will be collected upfront this year:

- HS – 5 tournaments = \$75
- MS – 4 tournaments = \$60
- Elementary – 3 tournaments = \$45

Fees will be collected through TeamSnap payment. Team managers will communicate the payment link.

Additional tournaments can be entered and paid individually through your team manager.

TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE

Travel Tournaments - Texas State NASP Tournament

State – **(NEW!)** San Antonio, TX,
March 20-21, 2026

- All archers should plan on competing one of the days.
- State Qualifier in January, a must to attend State
- Registration fee included in season registration rate.



TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE

Travel Tournaments - Nationals and Open Championship

Nationals - Salt Lake City, UT, April 23-25, 2026

- Must shoot a good State Score to qualify.
- Registration fee covered by program if attending.

Open/Championship - Daytona, FL, June 18-20

- Two tiers – same Tournament
- “Open” is open to all archers.
- “Championship”, must score well at Nationals to qualify.

ARCHERY PRIVATE LESSON

- Beginning in November, every other Sunday, ramp up later in season.
- First come first served.
- SignUpGenius link on our website.
- ***If you sign up and do not show up, you are still responsible for the payment and will not be allowed to sign-up again without penalty turn.***
- These are valuable slots, and the instructor has set aside his personal time for you. Repeat offenders will be banned from the ability to schedule a lesson. If willing to share, please state so and put your archer's average score.
